Catholic Services Appeal Weekend 2022 Theme: Fuel the Mission

On the first weekend of May, we began collecting pledges for the annual Catholic Services Appeal. This year's goal for St. Jane Frances de Chantal parish is \$91,138.00. As you are aware the Catholic Services Appeal has been in existence for many years and has been very successful.

You are also aware that when we surpass our targeted amount that the money over and above our target stays in the parish. Some of the ministries that the Catholic Services Appeal supports are: the Marriage Tribunal, Clergy and Consecrated Life, Evangelization and Missionary Discipleship, Mass for the Homebound, Sacred Heart Major Seminary, Lay Ecclesial Ministers and Leadership Development just to name a few.

Many enrichment programs that are put on by the Archdiocese in parishes are underwritten by the Catholic Services Appeal. This appeal benefits everyone. I would ask that you be as generous as you possibly can. You may have already received a C.S.A. mailing from the Archdiocese of Detroit. If you have already made a pledge to this year's appeal, I thank you for your generous contribution. If for some reason you did not receive a pledge packet we will provide one for you. They are available in the Gathering space and the parish office.

The Catholic Services Appeal is one of the appeals that I contribute to annually. Throughout the years I have benefitted from this appeal in many ways. The appeal does so much good work within the Church and the Archdiocese of Detroit. In previous parishes that I have been assigned people will ask, "Well Father, how much do you give to the Catholic Services Appeal." I have always made a nine month pledge and this year's pledge will be \$2,300.00.

Thanks to the parishioners of St. Jane Frances, our storage room was FULL of medical items after Masses last week. They are now on their way to a clearing house to be prepped for shipping to Ukraine. But please don't stop there.....this weekend the Parish Nurses are again accepting donations of medical supplies in the Gathering Space. That is the beauty of this church: a request is made and you answer the call. If you forget to bring in your items this weekend, you can still bring them in Monday morning (June 13th) before the nurses take them to the staging place.

Today is Most Holy Trinity Sunday, when we celebrate the mystery of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit as three Persons, but united as one. This concept has always been a mystery to me, but I simply accept it. Our Choir Prelude 'One Lord', speaks of the 'oneness' of this mystery: one Lord, one faith, one call to serve each other, one heart, one mind, one common ground, we stand now as one.

CHOIR NOTES: I am thankful for my dedicated choir members and Cantors. In a couple weeks, the choir will take a break from Wednesday rehearsals, though we'll still be singing at Mass each Sunday morning since our ministry doesn't simply end in June. Plus, we always practice a number of songs to be used during Ordinary Time, so they are prepped and ready. However, we are always seeking new members for the Music Ministry whether you are a singer or play an instrument....especially trumpet. Please see me after Mass if you'd like to join us.

As we conclude the Easter season and begin Ordinary Time, we'll also be using different music for the Holy Holy, Mystery of Faith, Great Amen, and Lamb of God. Watch for that information next week.

A while ago, I came across an article from the Leek Pipe Organ Company which was aimed at music ministers as we go about our special work for the Lord....and it is indeed special. Sometimes we need a boost because with any profession – ministerial or otherwise - it can be rewarding, but it can also leave one feeling exhausted at times. It takes a great deal of dedication to be able to plan and practice week after week, in preparation to play and sing music during Masses every weekend. This ministry is essential to the church and does allow members of the congregation to come alive and be able to express themselves during worship, through song as well as prayer. No doubt everyone recalls how much music was missed during COVID. I'll share a few motivational quotes that were included in the article...and feel free to use or mold them for yourselves if YOU need a spiritual boost!

Albert Schweitzer: "If you are called upon to play a church service, it is a greater honor than if you were to play a concert on the finest organ in the world... Thank God each time when you are privileged to sit before the organ console and assist in the worship of the Almighty."

Igor Stravinsky: "The Church knew what the psalmist knew: Music praises God. Music is well or better able to praise Him than the building of the church and all its decoration; it is the Church's greatest ornament."

Johann Sebastian Bach: "Where there is devotional music, God is always at hand with His gracious presence."


