## A Lenten Project

I hope your Lent is going well. There are many ways in which we can deepen our spiritual life throughout this season of Lent. During this season of Lent we are also called to remember those who are in need of our prayers.

A few weeks ago, I shared with you some facts about the number of priests who are serving within the Archdiocese of Detroit and as of today there are 209 priests. In 2030, there will be 157 priests. Also an interesting fact is that in 2027, I will be retiring. Even with the declining numbers of priests the needs of the people are still being met. As I have mentioned to my brother priests on several occasions, the church will look very different in ten years.

I truly believe that God will provide for His church, He always has. I also believe that we are called to ask and to encourage people to consider a vocation to priesthood or religious life. Each of us comes in contact with people everyday that may have a vocation to serve the church.

As we pray for vocation within the church, asking God to touch the hearts and minds of people to serve the needs of the church, we also pray for the people who have responded to God's call. We pray for Pope Francis, for Bishops, for retired religious men and women, and for retired priests who have served the church for decades. In our prayer we remember pastors and associate pastors who are at present serving the needs of the people in parishes across the Archdiocese of Detroit. We remember in a special way those religious men and women who are sick, infirmed and dying.

In an address that St. Pope John Paul II gave to a group of young people he said; "Good Shepherd, teach the young people gathered here, teach the young people of the world, the meaning of "laying down" their lives through vocation and mission."

Each of us are given a vocation to share that vocation in service to the mission of the Church, namely to proclaim, to manifest and make known the love that Jesus Christ has for all of us.

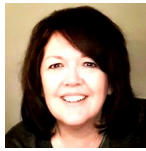

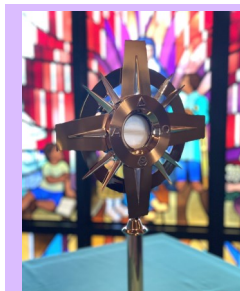
### WASHING OF THE FEET

At the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday, April 6<sup>th</sup> at 7:00pm, Fr. Tony will wash the feet of 12 parish members. The foot washing on Holy Thursday may seem somewhat strange and old-fashioned. The church has kept it in the liturgy for good reason. As Christ washed the feet of his disciples at the Last Supper, emphasizing for them the connection between Eucharist and service to others, this ritual remains in our liturgy for the same reason. It is to emphasize that the Eucharist is not separate from service, but that they are inextricably bound together. The essential nature of Holy Communion is unity, not only with God, but also with one another. Having your feet washed in this way is a powerful and humbling encounter with the heart of discipleship! **If you would like to participate in this beautiful act of service, please contact me via phone or email.**

### RCIA

During the Lenten season, we ask you to pray for our Adults seeking Initiation. **I would like to ask you to also give them a card with a note of welcome to the parish.**

A simple Easter card is sufficient, and the note need be nothing more than "Welcome to St. Jane Frances." These cards will then be given to the newly Initiated after the Easter Vigil. **REFLECTION**

Jesus used water as an example to the Samaritan woman to show her how important it was to have Jesus in her life. Without Jesus, our souls are dead. He is the living water that makes our souls well and strong, just like physical water makes our bodies, as well as pets, and plants grow and be strong.

**DISCUSSION**

- What do you like to drink when you are thirsty?
- Who would you like to have a discussion about Jesus with?

**FAMILY ACTIVITIES**

**CLEARLY JESUS:** Take a picture and cover it with several sheets of waxed paper. Talk about how you can't see the image clearly. As you remove sheets of waxed paper, think about how the closer we are to Jesus, the better we will know Him.

**TASTE TEST:** Take your favorite treat or snack and begin to eat it with your family present. Describe how delicious it is and how it tastes. Ask the others if they are content to only know the treat by listening to you talk about it or if they want some for themselves. Point out that just as we want to taste the treat for ourselves, we need to know Jesus for ourselves.

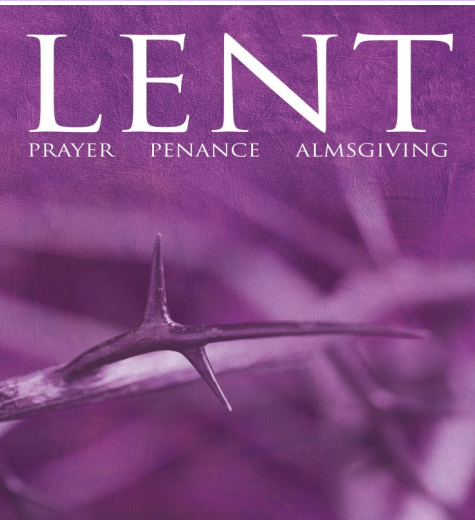
