The priority for our contribution is to:

- Advance equity and transformational change that makes a big difference to people's quality of life, and system focused solutions that are hapori/hapū/iwi-led

Pūtea Toro Criteria

To be considered for this fund, applications must fit one or more of the three criteria below:

1. Advance equity:

- enhance wellbeing
- strengthen identity
- connection and access to opportunities
- Grow leadership

2. Strengthen collaboration and support collective action including:

- Supporting connected and collective efforts to shift the conditions holding problems in place

3. Grow capacity for system-focused solutions

- Support changemakers, disrupter and influencers to advance their skills, capacity and influence

A link to an online application may be sent to you if your request strongly aligns to the Pūtea Toro criteria.

The Te Kāwai Toro Committee consider the application which could take up to four weeks.
