Beverly Recreation will now reserve your choice of four picnic areas at Lynch Park for small functions! Reservations are made in 4-hour time slots, starting at 8:00am and ending at 8:00pm. Cost is \$25/4-hour block for Beverly residents and \$50/4-hour block for non-Beverly residents. Driving through the park to drop off supplies and/or equipment will be at the discretion of the Park Ranger.

PLEASE NOTE: The Lynch Park Picnic Area reservation fee *does not* include the parking fee for non-resident cars and we cannot guarantee parking for all cars in your party. The parking fee is \$10 on weekdays and \$20 on weekends. Lynch Park rules apply to all visitors and include: no tents or canopies, use of the band shell or live music, alcoholic beverages, party rentals or pets are prohibited.

The Following Restrictions Apply to **ALL PARKS**:

- At the discretion of Beverly Recreation, certain dates during the season will not be available for group events.
- Groups with more than 30 children visiting a beach must bring at least 2 lifeguards and check in with the Head Lifeguard on duty. All groups attending beaches must follow Christian's Law (MGL c. 111, §127A½).
- All trash must be disposed of properly or removed from the park.
- **No caterers allowed** without permission from Beverly Recreation and a permit from the Health Department **(978-921-8591).**
- No alcohol, tents, canopies, umbrellas, or charcoal grills allowed at any time.
- No sound systems or party rentals (dunk tank, moonbounce, etc.) allowed.
- **No live music** without written permission. Use of band shells or pavilions for music is restricted to City of Beverly events. Recorded music must be kept at a reasonable volume at all times.
- All participants must park in legal, designated parking areas only. Parking is prohibited along driveways, on grass areas or in fire lanes.
- NO DOGS ALLOWED from Memorial Day weekend to Labor Day! Dogs MUST be on leash at all times!
- Use of any courts or fields are on a first-come, first-served basis unless a permit has been issued.

The Following Restrictions Apply to **CAMPS & SCHOOLS using LYNCH PARK:**

- Approval of this request does not exclude any non-resident groups from paying the parking fee
- From Memorial Day weekend to Labor Day Non-Resident Fees are:
 - Cars: \$10 weekdays / \$20 weekends & holidays
 - Bus Parking: \$75 per bus (at all times, even if the buses are not parking at Lynch Park)
 - NOTE: Beverly schools are exempt from the bus parking fee

The Following Restrictions Apply to LYNCH PARK:

- At the discretion of Beverly Recreation:
 - Certain dates during the season will not be available for group outings.
 - Groups that arrive at the park without a reservation may be denied entry based on scheduled events or anticipated crowds.
- A certified lifeguard, who must check in with the Beverly Recreation Head Lifeguard upon arrival, must accompany groups of up to 30 children, who plan to use the beaches.
- Any group with more than 30 children must bring 2 lifeguards.
- Groups arriving by bus must pay the bus fees even if the buses are not staying in the parking lot. The
 bus fee is a usage fee and helps defer the cost of large groups using the park and facilities.
- REMINDERS FOR ALL GROUPS:
 - Lynch Park is a Carry In/Carry Out park, so is the responsibility of all groups to take all trash home with them!
 - o The dumpsters at Lynch Park are for Recreation Department use only and are not available to the public.
 - Trash bags are available upon request and groups must arrange to remove their trash after using the park.
 - NO DOGS ALLOWED from Memorial Day weekend to Labor Day. Dogs MUST be on leash at all times, all year.
 - All visitors must park in the main parking lot. Access to the driveway is only to drop off disabled passengers, not to drop off equipment.
 - o No live music without written permission. Use of the band shell is restricted to City of Beverly events.
 - Restrooms will be open from Memorial Day to Labor Day, from 9:00 am − 8:00 pm.
 - At other times of the year, your group may have to assume the cost of opening, cleaning and closing the restrooms.
