

MAKING ENFIELD NORTH SAFER

After 14 years of Conservative government, crime and anti-social behaviour are at record levels, with 90% of crimes now going unsolved.

Here in Enfield, Community Policing has been decimated. Police do not have the resources to manage anti-social behaviour, with large parts of Enfield North still receiving no dedicated PCSO support.

Following four years of constant campaigning, I have secured more policing support for Enfield residents, with these resources arriving this year.

I have acted on residents' concerns about car meets across Enfield North. I have worked with local organisations, Enfield Council, private landowners, and local police to put in place physical barriers, and a commitment to a court injunction for a long term solution to this disturbance, particularly along the A10.

HOUSING CRISIS – TORY FAILURE

In her **45 days as Prime Minister**, Liz Truss broke our economy and families in Enfield are paying the price.

Mortgage and rent payments have skyrocketed. Those re-mortgaging, or first-time buyers, are finding it impossible.

Because of this Tory government, **Enfield North has also faced the highest rate of no-fault, Section 21 evictions in London.**

The Government promised to scrap no-fault evictions in 2019, and yet, families in Enfield are still being forcibly removed from their homes every week.

The Tories won't listen, **despite me raising it directly with the Prime Minister.** Only a Labour Government will support private renters and end this cruel practice.

This is a housing crisis caused by the Tories.

CHASE FARM UTC RE-OPENS

Following my campaign and extensive engagement with the management of the Hospital and the Health Secretary, Chase Farm Urgent Treatment Centre returned to its full-time opening hours of 8am – 10pm last October.

Over a year and a half ago the hours of the Urgent Care Centre were cut, with the centre closing early at 7.30pm. The service is essential for residents seeking urgent treatment and for tackling the backlogs we are all too familiar with.

Combined with the chronic shortage of local GPs in Enfield North, residents were left with no local reliable access to urgent healthcare.

As someone who has used Chase Farm’s Urgent Care Centre and seen **first-hand the amazing work the staff do there**, I know how important the service is for residents and its return to its previous opening hours will be welcomed by everyone.

BANKING HUB GETS GREEN LIGHT AFTER MY CAMPAIGN

Since 2020, local bank branches have been closing down one after another.

After two years of campaigning, including on-site visits with LINK, I was delighted when my application for a banking hub on Hertford Road was given the green light.

With a banking hub, we will have high street banks operating from it, allowing you to do your everyday banking like a traditional bank branch. It also means our local businesses don’t have to travel miles for basic needs like cash deposits. We all know how vital banks are to maintaining the vibrancy of our high streets.

Community banking and cash facilities are essential in communities where residents are not able to make full use of online banking services. I am working with LINK to ensure this service is delivered in 2024.

PROTECTING OUR LOCAL ENVIRONMENT

The green spaces and waterways in Enfield North are hugely important to everyone who lives here. These precious spaces should be protected and preserved for future generations to enjoy.

However, **this Tory government has failed to protect the environment** and it is local people who suffer as a result.

They have no plan to tackle toxic air quality or to prevent big water companies, like Thames Water, from releasing untreated sewage into our rivers. In **2022 alone there were 975 recorded sewage spills into the River Lea** before it reached Enfield North.

I’ve seen the impact of over **7,700 hours of sewage** being pumped into our river.

Labour would put Enfield residents first, **setting legally binding targets to end sewage dumping** in our waterways and cleaning up our cherished local rivers and canals.
