The paintings in this exhibition mark a moving on, or rather a moving through, his painterly language with the inclusion of further materials - dried flowers, splintered wood and plant fronds - denoting a body of work that is rooted in the new surroundings of his Somerset studio.

Helen explores class, diet and superstition through ceramic objects and food. She was influenced by her Northern grandmother, a thrifty but brilliant cook with something of the witch about her – highly superstitious and an inveterate tea leaf reader.


