LOOKING BACK

James Hudson Taylor set sail for China at 22 years old with only £10 in his pocket. By the time he died 51 years later, 129,000 Chinese had given their lives to Christ and more than 800 missionaries were on the field.

John Wesley lived in a disciplined ("methodical") way and spearheaded revival for about 50 years around the UK, seeing some of the poorest become converted. There was opposition, but by his death there were over 700,000 Methodists in the country.

William Booth founded the Salvation Army, known for street preaching and helping the poorest, e.g. by reforming how children were exploited in factories. By the end of his life the Army was in 55 nations and even Queen Victoria attended his funeral.

All seemed to be unlikely leaders.

KEY SCRIPTURES - WHAT DOES THE BIBLE SAY?

Hab 3:2 - Praying that God will do it again.

Hab 2:14 - The earth will be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the Lord.

Psalm 67 - Bless us that Your salvation may be released as we touch and bless others.

Isa 40:3-5 - Streams in dry ground (v3 was a key verse in the Hebridean revival.)

Psalm 24 - Read it as a prayer for revival.





LOOKING FORWARD

True revival has to lead to transformation of society, with thousands coming to Christ. We need leaders but what really matters is the Spirit of God anointing someone available to God, rather than great leadership skills, to bring eternal change...

We are called to be like John the Baptist, calling out in a wilderness and preparing the way of the Lord, in multiple cities and regions across the world.
