### Hate crime and hate incident support & reporting service for East and Southeast Asian communities, including Hong Kong BN(0) Status Holders

#### What is this project, and why is it needed?

The project seeks to address the rise in anti-Asian hate crime/incidents by providing an independently branded, community trusted, accessible, and well-used service consisting of a 24/7 helpline and a website. It will ask members of East and Southeast Asian communities, as well as the organisations that support them, for their feedback, opinions and experiences. These insights will enable the design of a service that breaks down barriers to reporting and ensures that victims/survivors of hate crime/incidents from all East and Southeast Asian communities, including newly arrived Hong Kong BN(O) holders, have access to the ongoing support that they need.

#### Who is funding this project?

The Consortium has been granted the <u>Third Party Hate Crime Reporting Service</u> <u>Fund from the Department for Levelling Up</u>, Housing and Communities. This research is being led by <u>End Violence and Racism Against East and Southeast Asian</u> <u>Communities (EVR)</u> who are part of a wider consortium of 14 organisations delivering this project.

#### Who is part of the Consortium?

There are 14 organisations in the Consortium. Their titles and websites can be seen on the next page. These organisations were chosen because they are national and regional community based groups with expertise in hate crime/incident reporting and prevention and supporting East and Southeast Asian victims/survivors of racial violence.


