
Rhyming Sort

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<u>Directions</u>

1.Print off the sorting page and the clip art page.

2. Cut on the lines of the clip art page. This will give you 16 pairs of pictures.

3. Have your child name the items in each pair. (You may need to repeat them aloud)

4. Decide if the two items rhyme or not.

5. If they do not rhyme, demonstrate how they still have a similar sound because they start with the same sound. You can show them with spelling also.

EXTEND THE LEARNING:

Have your child cut out pictures from newspapers & magazines. They will get cutting practice and have pictures to sort. You can sort by beginning sound, rhyming, or neither.
