Best Practices for Mobile Devices

- *Turn off the device when not in use.
- *Turn wifi on only when needed.
- Always place the mobile device on a solid surface.
- Viewing distance should be a minimum of 12 inches from the screen.



 - Public policy enacted




Public Servants Taking Action

- ► Worldwide actions




MA Towns Taking Action

Legal Solutions

- > FCC sued:
 - ► IRREGULATORS v. FCC
 - ► Environmental Health Trust
 - ► Children's Health Defense
 - ► CHD OTARD Rule: Rooftop cell towers
- ► Fay School ADA: Court recognizes non-thermal biological effects
- ► EHS: California Appellate Court holds that Wi-Fi sickness is a disability
- Chappaquiddick, Hull, Pittsfield, Centerville lawsuits



MA Policy Solutions

- ▶ 11 Sponsored bills this session
 - Senator Julian Cyr's <u>S. 186</u> Commission bill written by Consumer Protection Committee
 - Senator Michael Moore's <u>S. 2204</u> to opt out of utility smart meters
 - Rep. Dykema's H. 115 to address wi-fi in schools



PETITION OF:

Utility "Smart" Meters

- Maryland: largest U.S. water district halted AMI smart meters in December
- Pennsylvania: Supreme Court case (consent and effective accommodation)
- Vermont already offers no-fee opt-out
- ► ENMAX: opt-out customers <u>send in readings</u>
- ► Analog meters <u>readily available</u>
- ► Environmental justice/<u>Worcester</u>
- ► <u>TedX Talk</u>: Jeromy Johnson, engineer






Safe Tech Solutions: Municipal Level
