# TERMS AND CONDITIONS THESE ITEMS APPLY TO AND BECOME A PART OF THE BID NO EXCEPTIONS TO THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS WILL BE CONSIDERED

- 1. Bids must be submitted on the included form only. Each bid shall be placed in a separate envelope. Be sure the envelope is completely and properly identified and sealed, showing the bid name and number in the lower left-hand corner.
- 2. All bids shall be entered on the Bid Form enclosed or a copy thereof. Bids are to be typewritten or in ink. No bidder may withdraw his proposal for a period of thirty (30) days after the date and hour set for the opening of bids.
- 3. The bidder shall attach the manufacturer's name of the equipment or material to be furnished, type model numbers descriptive bulletins and specifications. All guarantees and warranties should be clearly stated. This data shall be sufficient detail to describe accurately the equipment or material to be furnished. Manufacturer's specifications, in respect to the successful bidder, shall be considered as part of the contract with Payne County.
- 4. Any exceptions or deviations from written specifications shall be identified in writing and attached to the bid form.
- 5. The enclosed affidavit for Filing with Competitive Bid MUST be returned with the bid.
- 6. Payne County reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any technicalities in the bidding.
- 7. Direct purchase of certain items of equipment or material by Payne County is exempt from Federal Excise Tax and Oklahoma Sales Tax. In such cases, the bidder shall quote prices which do not include Federal Excise Tax and Oklahoma Sales Tax.
- 8. Bid must show number of days required for delivery under normal conditions. Contractor must keep the County advised at all times of the status of the order. For any exception to the delivery date as specified on this order, vendor shall give prior notification and obtain written approval from the Purchasing Agent. Default in promised delivery date or failure to meet specifications, authorizes the County to purchase supplies elsewhere and charge the full increase of cost and handling to defaulting contractor.
- 9. Bidder agrees to defend and save Payne County from and against all demands, claims costs expense, damage and judgments based upon infringement of any patent to goods specified in this order or the ordinary use or operation of such goods by the County or use or operation of such goods in accordance with the bidder's direction.
- 10. If the bid requires a written contract, the successful bidders shall execute a written contract with the county within (10) days after submission of the contracts to said bidder.
- 11. This bid is submitted as a legal offer, and any bid when accepted by the County constitutes a firm contract.

# **Turnkey Generator Installation Bid Specifications**

#### Scope

Provide and install, on a turnkey basis, a standby generator and automatic transfer switch according to the following specifications.

#### Generator

100 kW, 120/208 volt, 3 phase, 0.8 power factor, 60 hertz Class H or better insulation UL 2200 listed 1800 rpm (higher speeds will not be accepted) +/- 1% voltage regulation, no load to full load 450 amp, UL listed mainline circuit breaker Digital, microprocessor based controller

Engine shutdowns for high temperature, low oil pressure, low coolant level, overcrank and overspeed

Running time meter

Spark ignited engine capable of running on natural gas or LP vapor with a separate inlet for each 65 amp, or greater, battery charging alternator

Unit mounted, 12 volt automatic battery charger with 6 amp, or greater, output

Starting battery and cables 120 volt jacket water heater

Sound attenuated weather enclosure

Constructed of steel

Locking door latches, keyed alike

Average sound level at full load shall not exceed 71 dB(A) when measured at 7 meters 5 year comprehensive warranty on all components other than normal wear items

A time delay activated output signal shall be provided to drive an external relay for selective load disconnect control.

The user interface shall be provided with test/reset modes. The test mode will simulate a normal source failure. The reset mode shall bypass the time delays on either transfer to emergency or retransfer to normal.

A set of contacts rated at 5 amps, 30 VDC shall be provided for a low voltage engine start signal. Auxiliary contacts rated at 10 amps, 250 VAC for switch position

Controller shall have an event data log that will store a minimum of 300 events

A fully programmable engine exerciser with at least seven independent routines to exercise the engine generator, with or without load on a daily, weekly, bi-weekly or monthly basis.

RS-485 communications port

NEMA 3R Secured enclosure

There shall be two single pole, 20 amp circuit breakers installed in the ATS. One for the battery charger and jacket water heater and one spare.

5 year comprehensive warranty

#### Installation

Install the generator and automatic transfer switch per the following:

All work shall meet state and local codes and be done in a neat and craftsman like manner.

All work shall be coordinated with the owner's representative.

Obtain necessary permits and inspections from the local jurisdiction having authority over the job site.

Contact Call Okie to locate utility and other lines within the installation area.

Coordinate with the power company for access to the secondary side of the transformer as needed and to schedule the cutover. Note: Cutover will need to be performed on a weekend.

Pour concrete pads for the transfer switch and the generator.

Transfer switch pad shall be located between the utility transformer and the building. Location of the generator pad shall be coordinated with the owner's representative. Pads shall have PVC conduits for power and control conductors stubbed up so that conduit will be within the "stub-up area" of both the generator and the transfer switch enclosures. No conduits shall be visible on the exterior of the enclosures.

Pads shall be at least 6 inches wider and 6 inches longer than the associated equipment that will be mounted on them.

Transfer switch pad shall be not less than 5" thick.

Generator pad shall be not less than 8" thick.

Pads shall be reinforced with no less than 3/8" steel rebar spaced at not more than 12" intervals.

Electrical

Underground feeders from utility transformer to building shall be interrupted with the transfer switch. Existing feeder conductors may be reused, providing they are in good condition, between the transformer and the transfer switch or between the transfer switch and the building distribution panel. New conductors will need to be pulled in where the existing conductors are too short to be reused. Splices will not be permitted.

Payne County Health Dept, Generator Install Specifications, Page 3

Install PVC conduits underground from the transfer switch to the generator. There shall be separate conduits for the 450 amp power circuit, the remote start circuit and the 120 volt, 20 amp circuit for the battery charger and jacket water heater.

Pull in and terminate properly sized conductors. All new conductors shall be copper with at least 90° C insulation.

Properly ground all equipment per NEC requirements. Backfill and compact all trenches.

#### Gas

Appropriate gas line to be run from pre-existing line located parallel to proposed site of generator. Gas line connection will be located 100 feet from the gas meter. Trench from gas meter to generator and install no less than 2" pipe of a type that is approved for natural gas and underground installation by state and local codes. After pressure test has been approved, connect pipe to gas meter and to generator fuel inlet using provided flex hose.

There must be a shutoff valve installed at the generator fuel inlet. Backfill and compact trench.

# Startup Inspection and Testing

Coordinate all startup inspections and testing with owner's representative as the owner's representative(s) may want to observe.

Startup inspections must be performed by a technician authorized by the manufacturer(s) of the generator and transfer switch to perform startup inspections. Follow the manufacturers' recommended procedures and complete and submit

manufacturers' forms to initiate warranties. Provide copies to owner.

After startup, calibration and all timers are set, perform power failure test by opening utility circuit breaker in the transfer switch. Let the generator run under site load for at least 30 minutes. Close the utility circuit breaker in the transfer switch to restore utility power. Let all timers time out for automatic retransfer, engine cool down and shut down. Instruct owner's representative(s) in operation of system.

#### Maintenance

Provide 5 years of preventative maintenance as follows:

2 visits per year at 6 month intervals

Perform a complete preventative maintenance inspection of the system at each visit Test operation of system at each visit

During one visit annually, replace the oil and oil filter and pull a sample of the used oil. Send the oil sample to an independent laboratory for analysis. Report any abnormalities in the oil to the owner.

At years 2 and 4, also replace the starting battery, spark plugs and air filter.

At year 3, drain and flush cooling system and replace all cooling system hoses, coolant and all belts.

Provide owner with inspection reports after each inspection.
