Alternating Possession Arrow:

*The alternating possession arrow must start off in the centre
- from here, whoever gains possession of the ball from the first tap, the arrow goes the opposite way*

NOTE: *The key here is that it doesn't go by who won the tap, it goes by who gains control of the ball after the tap.*

*- Every time the referee does the conventional jump ball signal - the arrow must be changed, **remembering to wait until the ball has been thrown into court.***

The arrow also moves:

- WHEN THE BALL HAS BEEN THROWN IN AT QUARTER TIME & THREE QUARTER TIME!!

AT HALF TIME:

- The arrow must move twice; firstly, when the referee comes to the score table, let him/her know that you are changing the arrow (this is because the teams switch ways; so you're switching it to make sure that the same team who was entitled to that possession gets it back) and then when they throw the ball in you switch it again.

REMEMBER TO SWITCH THE ARROW TWICE AT HALF TIME!!
