"Black Lives Matter: End Black Men as Bait!"

It is an honor to speak to you today. "The Fatherhood Coalition" can take the lead as a national model. "Defund the Police" can work by shifting resources to reentry guidance, mental health treatment, substance use treatment, housing, education and employment. Those preventive measures can drastically reduce recidivism = reduced post incarceration crime = reduced need for police intervention = reduced money to DCPD. The money saved should be reinvested in the community work that you do, not in tax cuts. This is called "pay-4-performance." The more The Fatherhood Coalition brings fathers back into the fold, the more the organization should be funded thru these net savings.

We must socially reengineer the current prison-industrial-complex thru cultural competence as the ANTITHESIS of MORE POLICING! Treating our men and women humanely with the wrap around physical services (housing, education/mentoring, employment, etc.) augmented by "spiritual" guidance (fatherhood and family counseling) will greatly increase TRUST. As you know, it is that earned Trust in US that will enable us to reduce anxiety/depression, anger, reactive violence, and thereby reduce future anti-social activity.

Judge demands plan for inmate reductions at D.C. jail, finds 'deliberate indifference' to prisoners'

health in pandemic



As of mid-May, the confirmed infection rate per capita for inmates behind bars at D.C. jail facilities was 13.5 percent, nearly 14 times that for the city's population as a whole, Kollar-Kotelly wrote. A May 22 sampling of 304 symptom-free inmates found 4.6 percent tested positive.


Overall, D.C. officials report that 207 inmates and 86 corrections workers have tested positive, and one inmate and one worker have died.


This article further supports a consistent pattern in DC of brutality towards Black men:

- (1) A pattern of "stop and frisk" with Black men arrested at 10 x the rate of whites
- (2) refusal of DCPD and DoH to be trained and provided Narcan In the face of an opioid epidemic
- (3) continued incarceration over treatment referral for substance use disease
- (4) consistent pattern of discharge from incarceration without direct connection to ongoing mental health, medical, and substance use treatment
- (5) discharge from incarceration with inadequate transitional community housing
- (6) proposed increased funding to DCPD and funding cuts to violence interrupters and community support services for returning citizens

All of the above put the retuning citizen and entire community at risk for PREVENTABLE crime, infectious diseases, and personal injury. This is a classic revolving door setup for the DC Prison Industrial Complex.

Black Lives Matter... it's time our government officials put the money where their mouth is! If not vote them out!

In the racial tension sequence, he tells the people to calm down.


In the evening, he plays music for all the lovers.
