





## Medical Services

### RX Assistance Programs and Access Tools

- ▶ CHIP- Children's Health Insurance Program and Children's Medicaid
- Astra Zeneca Resource List
- Patient Access Network Foundation (PAN)
  - Offers grants for individuals with specific medical conditions. The grant period is typically one-year and the individual may or may not qualify for the whole amount.
- Medicine Assistance Tool (MAT)
  - Patients can search for medication assistance based on their condition, location, etc. This tool provides potential resources for those patients based on the information entered.
- RX Hope
  - ▶ Has a large amount of name brand prescriptions that qualified individuals can receive free of charge. Must apply through physician.





#### Transportation Access Cont.

- TXDOT received 75 million in Federal grants to put toward rural transportation access:
  - "The grant will enable rural transit providers to continue operating established transit routes and to add new services to aid communities, including necessary trips to work and medical appointments. Some services such as meal delivery and other critical services are also being provided."











- More than half, 57%, of food insecure residents who are eligible to receive SNAP in 2019 are not participating in the program



#### Broadband Access in the County


- ▶ 93.4% households with a computer



#### Brazosport College Programs

- In conjunction with Workforce Solutions, Brazosport College has several Adult Education and Literacy training sites throughout the county.
  - Classes include GED preparation, Occupational Skills Training, English as a Second Language (ESL) and Civics course
  - Locations in Pearland (2 sites), Alvin, Angleton, Lake Jackson, and Freeport
    - ▶ These sites are in the larger cities of Brazoria County and all but exclude the rural zones of the county. Cities like Sweeney, West Columbia, Bailey's Prairie, etc. are far from any one of these locations.
- Jumpstart Program
  - Available at no cost to eligible students
  - Includes programs for Phlebotomy, Electrical and Pipefitting, Office Administration, and Medical Billing and Coding
  - ▶ Allows low-income students to receive career training and certifications that gives them greater opportunity when searching for a high paying job.



- Universal Service Administrative Co.
  - ▶ Reduces the monthly bill amount for internet and/or telephone service for qualifying individuals through their lifeline support program.
- ► Federal Lifeline Assistance Program
  - Provides free phone and limited number of minutes to <u>qualifying citizens</u> through Assurance Wireless. Can qualify for an Emergency Broadband Benefit too.
  - Two programs:
    - Assured Wireless Unlimited- Unlimited minutes, texts, and data, plus free smartphone
    - Assured Wireless Lifeline Only- Unlimited minutes and texts, 4.5GB data, plus free smart phone
