

Learn the Tricks of the Trade

Local Disc Golf Player/Coach Shares Knowledge and Secrets of the Sport

Most people have already heard of disc golf since it's been around for over half a century. People also probably know that disc golf evolved from the tossing of a frisbee, created by a company called Wham-O back in 1966. What most people don't know is that in 1970 a small group of people from Rochester, NY, started using the frisbee not just for tossing around in the backyard but to play games of disc golf, forming leagues and hosting tournaments.

I caught up with a local disc golf player and coach, my good friend Ben Campbell. Ben is the Houghton University Disc Golf Coach and an expert in the sport for obvious reasons. Ben kindly consented to a session of questions and answers, sharing his knowledge.



JAPANESE INSPIRED GOLF

Bigfoot Park Golf NOW Open in Ellicottville

Ellicottville is the excursion chameleon of Western New York. It's equally fun and active no matter the season.. As we crawl out of a rainy spring and our weather apps start to show the sunshine emoji more consistently, we can officially start to celebrate summer in Ellicottville!

There definitely isn't a shortage of things to do in town this summer, with lots of biking, skating, hiking, and golf to take advantage of. However, if you're looking to try something new, Bigfoot Park Golf on Robbins Road, behind the Ellicottville Distillery, is about to open!

Park Golf is a twist of traditional golf, originating from Japan. Park golf combines elements of traditional golf and mini golf. Think of a regular golf course, but a little bit smaller and easier to play. The ball used is larger, about tennis ball-sized, and only one club is used and is designed specifically for the game.

"It's like a cross between a driver and a mallet", said Chad Neal, a bartender at Madigan's in Ellicottville. Chad also works on the Village Planning Board, and newly (and excitingly), Chad is the owner of Bigfoot Park Golf!

He is the man responsible for bringing this new sport to the area; an Ellicottville local who has been playing golf most of his life. He graduated High School on the Ellicottville Central High School golf team and went on to be a member of the Holiday Valley Men's League. "I actually won the championship in 2006 with Joe Clark," Chad said proudly.

Chad represents some of the best that summer in Ellicottville has to offer. When it comes to Park Golf and wanting to add to the summer adventures in town, Chad discovered the sport with his two sons, Elliott and Grayson, up in Akron, New York. "We ended up being near Akron on an excursion one day, so we stopped in only to see WWF's Destroyer himself sitting at the end waving at us as we drove in," Chad shared. Chad and his sons, avid WNY activity-goers, fell in love with park golf. "After our 7th visit, I uttered to the boys, 'We should build a park golf course in Ellicottville!'. They agreed and we clamored are ideas for proving it." on ideas for naming it."





Bigfoot Park Golf is located in the large field behind the Ellicottville Distillery. Owner Bryan Scharf had featured a cutout of the illusive mountain monster Bigfoot before the Neal boys began to craft their course. Rather than evict Mr. Foot, they ran with it, giving their course a name! "Plus all the Bigfoot that live in the hills around here too," added

Moreover, on the gameplay, "The fairways and greens are cut from 35-100 yards and are par 3, 4, and 5", said Chad. These are definitely shorter than a traditional golf hole, with the average par 5 reaching up to 550 yards in length. The hole itself is 8 inches to accommodate the larger ball, and Chad implies the course's features are at a family-friendly difficulty level: "No sand traps or water hazards but the rough can be a struggle."








SWING INTO YOUR NEXT ROUND OF GOLF

Whether You're a Seasoned Pro or New to the Sport, These Area Courses Invite You to Experience an Afternoon on the Greens

Now that warm weather is here to stay, there's no better time to dust off the clubs and head out to one of the area's beautiful golf courses! Whether you're in it for the fresh air or the friendly competition, golf is a great sport for people of all ages and abilities and offers the perfect opportunity to spend time with friends and meet new people. Not sure if swinging a club is for you? Consider giving disc golf a try! With minimal equipment and plenty of local opportunities to learn, it just might be the sport that gets your whole family outdoors every weekend this summer!

BIRCH RUN GOLF CLUB

Located at 4130 Birch Run Road in Allegany, Birch Run Golf Club is a regulation length par 35 golf course owned by Bob Ketchner. While memberships are available, the course is also open to the public and hosts several tournaments throughout the season. "We pride ourselves in giving the best golf situation and golf experience for your dollar," said Ketchner. "Our course is in great shape. We try to give a friendly environment for people to come and enjoy themselves and still respect the game of golf, have a good time, and challenge themselves."



Unlike other golf clubs, Birch Run doesn't require tee times. "We just do open golf," Ketchner explained. "Basically, you can show up and play. We do receive phone calls (716-373-3113) to check on the status of play and the pace of play. If we're exceptionally busy, we'll let them know but most of the time they can get out on the course in a relatively timely manner." Ketchner is looking forward to great weather this summer, though he's glad Birch Run can handle the occasional downpour. "Fortunately, the course does take a lot of rain very well," he noted. "It drains very well so we can get a lot of rain, but then we're back and able to let carts out with really no restrictions." TWIN TIERS DISC GOLF





Twin Tiers Disc Golf is a volunteer-based non-profit organization devoted to providing the community with opportunities to play disc golf, especially for youth. Rich Longer, who's been enjoying disc golf for over 10 years, is pleased to share that disc golf is going strong at Olean's Gargoyle Park, which was Twin Tiers' very first disc golf course. While Longer was collaborating with the city of Olean to install this course, he worked contemporaneously with other municipalities to install disc golf courses, thus providing more opportunities for the community to engage in the sport. Shortly after completing the course in Gargoyle Park, Twin Tiers was awarded a grant by the Ralph Wilson Foundation to put in a youth disc golf course in Franchot Park. "There's a course in Callahan Park in Bradford, Pennsylvania that just had its ribbon cutting this Sunday," Longer said. Twin Tiers is also in the process of working with Allegany State Park to install a disc golf course.

Joe Henton of Twin Tiers has been thrilled to see participation in disc golf grow exponentially over the past few years. "We just hit 10,000 rounds played [at Gargoyle Park] in the few short years since it's been installed," Henton explained. "During the first year it was maybe 1,500 rounds, the next year we had 3,000 rounds, and the year after that we had 6,000 rounds and there's just no sign of it slowing down." He noted that interest was almost nonexistent in the early days, but now weekends are so busy that there are sometimes wait times in the park! "The response from the community has just been amazing," he added.

Both Longer and Henton note that one of the best attributes of the sport is its accessibility, both in terms of player ability and cost. Henton said, "The vast majority of disc golf courses [including Twin Tiers' courses] are free to play and there's no need to schedule tee times. If there is someone there already, you're able to go to a different hole and start your game as normal and finish as normal – it's not going to affect your pace of playing. The way to get started is to just acquire your first disc, which is a \$20 investment at most."

Henton noted that people of all ages and ability levels can be seen at Gargoyle Park enjoying disc golf, from young children to adults using electric wheelchairs and walkers. For those who are interested, it's easy to get involved! Visit www.twintiersdiscgolf.org for the 2024 schedule of tournaments and events, as well as league nights, at Twin Tiers' courses. 

Breakaway Classic Adventures: Disc Golf Has Roots Right Here in WNY

Most people have already heard of disc golf since it's been around for over half a century. People also probably know that disc golf evolved from the tossing of a frisbee, created by a company called Wham-O back in 1966.

What most people don't know is that in 1970 a small group of people from Rochester, NY, started using the frisbee not just for tossing around in the backyard but to play games of disc golf, forming leagues and hosting tournaments. In 1973, they teamed up with the City of Rochester to host the Disc Frisbee Championship featuring disc golf as the main event. By 1974 the semiannual City of Rochester Disc Golf Championship, named the American Flying Disc Open (AFDO), became a national tournament offering a brand new 1974 Datsun B210 as the Grand Prize!

At the Disc Golf World Championships in 1984 in Rochester, NY, the control of the PDGA (Professional Disc Golf Association) was handed over to its players, led by a player named Ted Smethers. A glistening green bottle of Genesee Cream Ale was used as a ceremonial bottle of champagne, celebrating the historic event!

The PDGA was even "headquartered" for many years in Toronto, Ontario, Canada by then Executive Director, Brian Hoeniger before he and his wife moved to Augusta, Georgia. In 2002 the new home of the PDGA was built there, on a 90-acre piece of land in Wildwood Park, offering three courses, a clubhouse, and a pro shop. Take that, MASTERS!

In 1983 a new disc company called Champion Discs (known today as Innova Discs) debuted a new disc called the Eagle. The Eagle, replacing the ever-popular frisbee style discs, represented a quantum leap in technology and instantly became the hot new disc that everyone was throwing. Innova was also responsible for developing a Flight Rating System to describe a disc's intended flight, used by every modern-day manufacturer. Flight Ratings are broken down into a set of four positive or negative numbers usually printed on the front of each disc describing its speed, glide, turn and fade. The higher the number the more pronounced its behavior in flight. Based upon the first number, the disc is described as either a Putter (lowest number) to Distance Drivers (highest number) with Midrange and Fairways Drivers in between.

I caught up with a local disc golf player and coach, my good friend Ben Campbell. Ben is the Houghton University Disc Golf Coach and an expert in the sport for obvious reasons, and a great source of information. Ben kindly consented to a session of questions and answers, sharing his knowledge and secrets in playing the sport.

INDREK: Refresh me on techniques that beginners should focus on and what are some common mistakes they make?

BEN: It's a disc, not a frisbee. Modern day discs are much smaller than a frisbee and require a lot more torque. Normally this means having to throw with a lot more technique and form to generate enough power.

Beginners also get carried away with disc selection. Stick to throwing putters and possibly, midrange discs until you find that you're overpowering them; excessive wobble or a disc that wants to turn immediately toward the ground are good signs that you need to get a faster speed disc. You will find that you'll be able to throw your putter and midrange just as far - if not farther - than a fairway or distance driver at the start.





INDREK: Could you give me your definition of terms again? For example: anhyzer vs. hyzer, understable vs. overstable with corresponding numbers, and when you want to use either or? Finally, when do you want to throw a disc backhand vs. forehand?

BEN: An anhyzer (outside edge of the disc tilted upwards) allows the disc to turn more in the beginning of the flight. This normally helps increase the distance a disc will fly. A hyzer (outside edge of the disc tilted downwards) decreases the amount of turn in the beginning of the flight, causing it to hook more in one direction and normally amounts in less distance.

An understable disc is defined as a disc that has more turn in the beginning of the flight than fade at the end of the flight. A disc with the numbers 6, 5, -4, 1 will be a very understable disc. The last two numbers of the flight chart tell the user whether the disc is understable, stable, or overstable. The 3rd number will be from 0 to -4. 0 means no turn (stable), and -4 means the most amount of turn. The last number is the amount a disc fades back after the initial turn. This can be from 0 to 4. 0 meaning no fade and 4 meaning the most fade.

A backhand or forehand shot can be used interchangeably. Some holes set up better for a forehand or a backhand depending on the shape of the hole, how it begins, and finishes. In general, a disc thrown on a forehand, which spins counterclockwise, will have the opposite flight of a backhand.

INDREK: Tell me about proper throwing technique?

BEN: Proper form requires using your whole body to generate power. It starts with planting your feet, then thrusting your hips forward, then twisting the upper body, driving the elbow forward and lastly, following through with your hand.

Many beginners use a run-up to generate power in their throw, too early in their playing

With its rolling hills, dense forests, and serene waterways, McKean County offers a variety of trails that cater to all levels of hiking enthusiasts. Whether you're seeking a leisurely stroll or a challenging trek, you'll have the opportunity to connect with nature and explore the stunning landscapes of the Allegheny National Forest and beyond.

TRAIL CENTRAL

Known as Trail Central, McKean County has an expansive trail system for hiking and biking. For the adrenaline seeking mountain bikers, the Trails at Jakes Rocks, Pennsylvania's 2024 Trail of the Year, provides 35 miles of an exhilarating ride through rugged landscapes with well-maintained paths that showcase the forest's diverse flora and fauna. It features a variety of challenges, from the gentler Tuttletown and Coal Knob trails to the epic one-way Blacksnake gravity trail. The trails connect to Dewdrop Campground for convenient overnight stays. INTERVIEW

REDNECK WOMAN GRETCHEN WILSON JOINING BIG & RICH LIVE IN SALAMANCA

A Conversation with Gretchen

HULICK: How do you feel that you are recognized in the category of female singers known by their first names like Loretta, Cher, Janis and Dolly? **WILSON:** The names you mention are icons! I am not sure anyone can really describe what it feels like to be included in that category.

HULICK: You burst onto the music scene in 2004 with your first single, "Redneck Woman" from your debut album, *Here For The Party*, which won you a Grammy Award. Your second album, *All Jacked Up*, had your lead-off single, of the same name, become the highest debuting single for a female country artist at the time. Did you feel added stress that you had to keep up

with the success of those two songs?

WILSON: By the time we hit the 2nd album it was definitely stressful, but I didn't look at it that way at the time. We were all just trying to hold on - traveling all over the world touring, doing television shows and other media. We went to Europe three times and Australia once... crossed the international date line twice in a week! All of it was everything I wanted and dreamed of, but it was definitely a lot. but it was definitely a lot.

HULICK: You wrote "Redneck Woman" with John Rich of Big & Rich, who you are headlining with for your show here at Seneca Allegany Resort & Casino at the end of May. You have to be having so much fun touring with them. **WILSON:** We are family. We have been making music and memories together for more than 20 years! Sometimes I look over at my brothers in arms on either side of the stage... and our eyes meet... and I feel what I have every artist gets to feel at some point in their carear. Totality would be hope every artist gets to feel at some point in their career. Totality would be a good way to sum it up!

HULICK: You are a singer, songwriter, producer, entrepreneur and you started your own record company, "Redneck Records". What would you say is your favorite part of the business?

WILSON: There is a LOT of business to what I do. But getting to be creative (as a job) is well worth the paper pushing. 'Nothing good comes easy' is what my grandpa always said, so I always just try to start each day with the hardest task. By the time I get to the show in the evening, the hard part is over and it's time to party!

HULICK: Did you always want to be a singer/songwriter? **WILSON:** I started out singing in bar bands. So I used to think how good I was, was based on how much I could sound like other artists. When I finally started to write songs for myself, I was forced into finding my own sound. Thankfully I was good at songwriting. Being a hit songwriter is in my opinion, one of my greatest accomplishments.

HULICK: Who are your music idols? **WILSON:** I name-check most of them in 'Redneck Woman' - Lynyrd Skynyrd, Kid Rock, Hank Jr., Tanya Tucker, George Strait, but of course there's Dolly, Patsy, Merle Haggard, Willie, Waylon, Cash and well... I think you get the picture by now.

HULICK:You dropped out of school when you were in 9th grade. You received your GED at the age of 34. This led to you shining a light on the importance of adult education, which led to you receiving the National Coalition for Literacy Leadership Award. That has to be one of your shining moments. Can you talk a little bit about that?

WILSON: My sole purpose for doing that was for my daughter, Grace, who was around seven at the time. I didn't want her to think you can be this successful without an education. It's something that I should have done long before that, AND... it made me walk a little taller.

HULICK: You've worked and collaborated with so many artists. Is there

someone you'd like to work with that you haven't?

WILSON: Oh soooo many! But if I had to put a name at the top of that list it would be Travis Tritt. I have been a fan of his music and his voice for as long as he's been making music.

HULICK: You could say that you are not only a huge female country artist, but you can also consider yourself a perennial rocker with your connections to the songs of the female group, Heart. These days the hard line that existed between the genres of music in the past don't seem to exist anymore.

What are your thoughts?

WILSON: I grew up playing in bar bands. One minute it was Patty Loveless, the next minute it was Alice in Chains. My opinion is still the same as it was back in the Muzik Mafia days... It can be anything... as long as it's great!

HULICK: You seem to be an artist that thrives on live performances. How did you handle not being able to perform when the Covid-19 pandemic hit and everything shut down?

WILSON: I was forced to slow down, because I shattered my leg during that time, and it took months to recover. I feel so very fortunate to have my health back and to be back out there. I give God all the thanks and glory.

HULICK: Any new projects in the works?

WILSON: I have a new single in the works... should be hearing about it very

HULICK: What's the best part of being Gretchen Wilson? **WILSON:** I've just always tried to be honest in everything I do. My songs are me, so the person on stage is the same one doing laundry, cleaning my house, and taking care of my family... and a bunch of dogs.

HULICK: Describe what your perfect day would look like if you could do anything you wanted.

WILSON: Every day is perfect to me, whether I'm on tour, writing, recording or spending time with my daughter and mom. If you get up real early and have coffee with the amazing creation outdoors, it can only be great!




