

## How to create your mask?

Make your mask
from any object which
has a round shape and
which can be connected
by string (cardboard,
fabric, packaging, etc...)

It should cover the lower part of your face (from chin to nose), revealing your eyes.

Add elements on it to decorate it.

Warning! Please don't use a real surgical mask.

As for the equipment:
 do some recycling!
Use recycled materials, and it is suggested that you use small,
light ingredients
 to easily
hang them from
your mask

You can use pictures, electric cables, toys, cans, caps, plants, textiles, packaging, plastic bags, magazines, and other waste materials...

Relay a message related to COVID-19!





# Questions to ask yourself when creating your mask

Does your mask have a link with COVID-19 or with

environmental issues?

What does this pandemic reveal?
What "post-pandemic" world do you want?
So many starting points to express yourself with your mask!

Your voice counts!

Express your concerns about the health and environmental crisis and give life to your solutions to solve it!

Make sure your message is clear!

Choose a name for your mask: this name must be short and related to the meaning of your mask.

Prepare an explanation of your mask:
what does it represent?
What message you want
to convey with it?

#### How to take a perfect photo

Your eyes must be clearly visible, the mask must not hide them.

Set that as a goal.

Your eyes should be wide open, but not too much.



Very important :
your photo must be taken in
landscape format.

Do not hold the mask with your hands.

You can now post your photo to the Art of Change 21 website!

The background of the photo must be completely plain (use a sheet, for example). Painted walls, corners of walls, exteriors, etc. should be avoided as much as possible.



Do not mount your mask at eye level and cover up your eyes!

Do not write on the lower part of the mask (this will not be seen on the picture).

If you overload
your mask with too many items
then we may no longer be able
to see clearly its design.
Cover the base of your mask so that the
background of the mask
no longer appears.

Here are some examples of photo fails.

#### Mistakes to avoid

Do not compose your photo in portrait.
Use a landscape format, like here.
