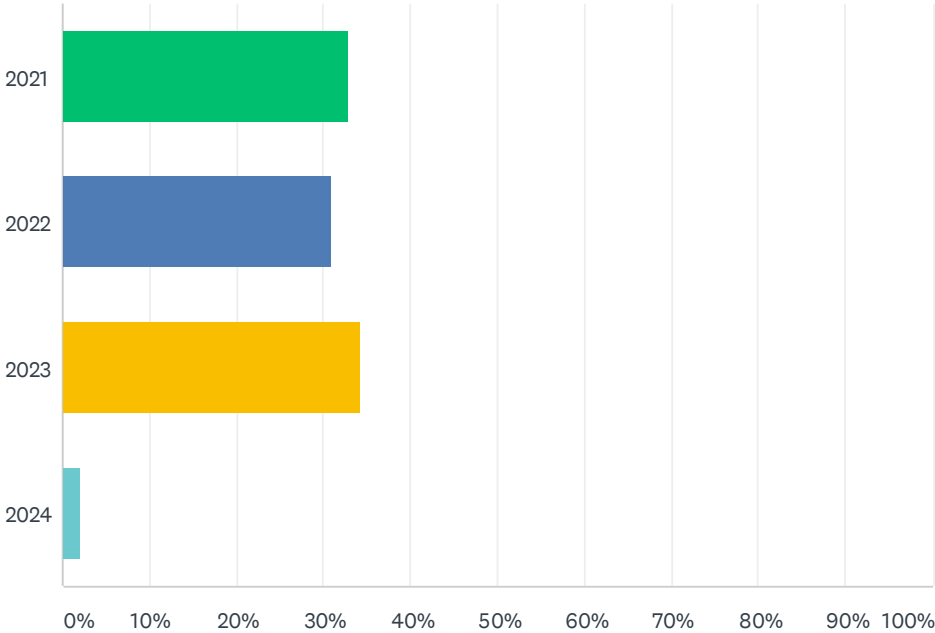

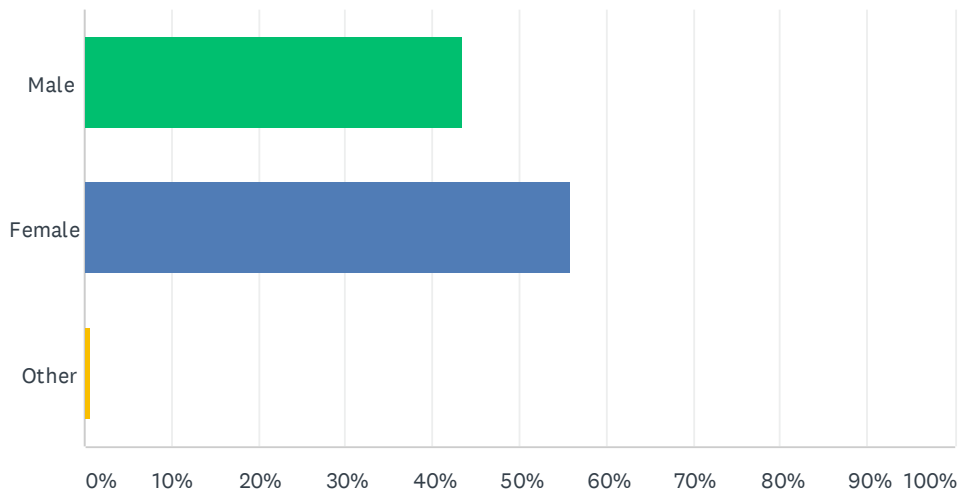

Q2 Gender

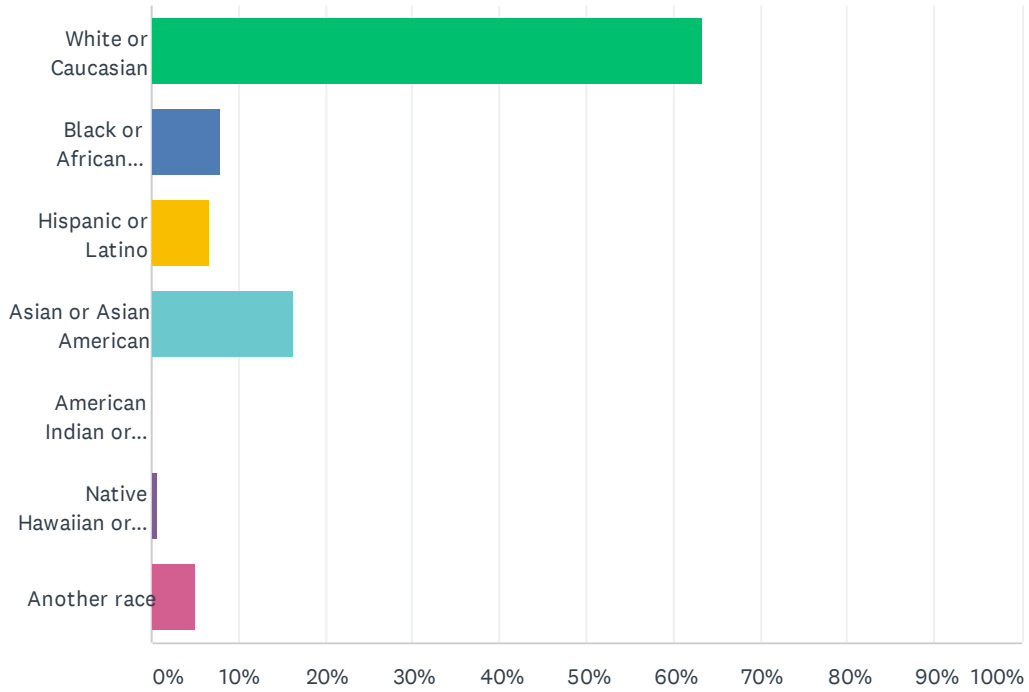

Q3 Select the race with which you most identify

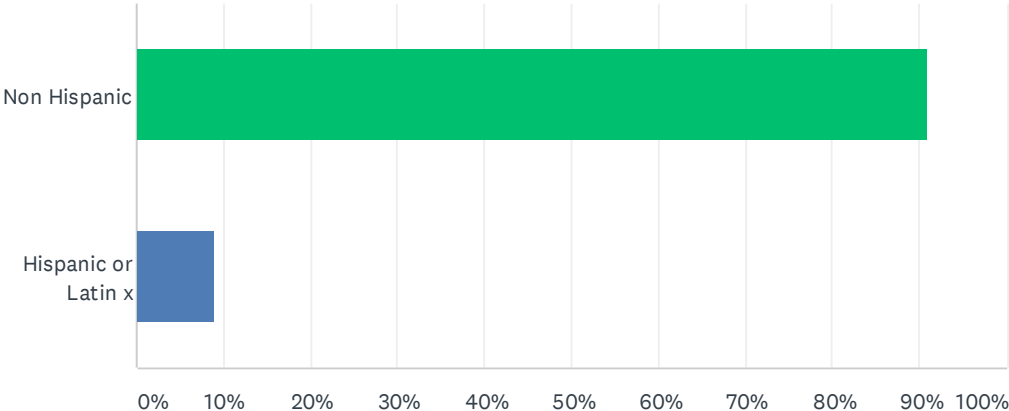

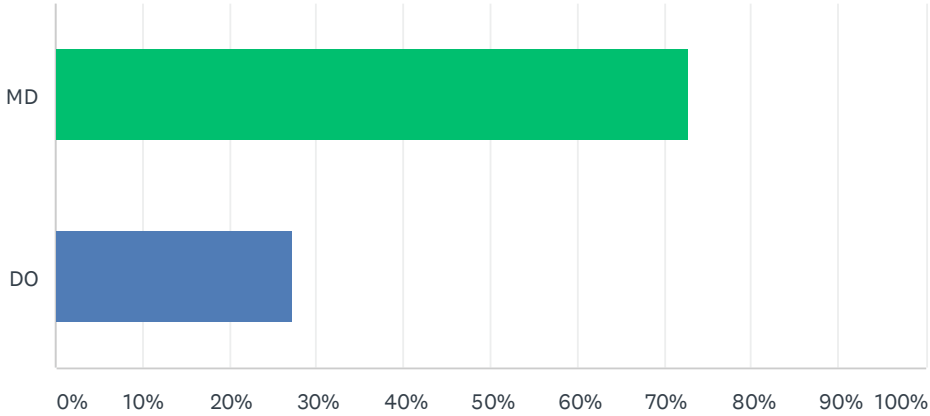

Q6 What medical degree do you have?

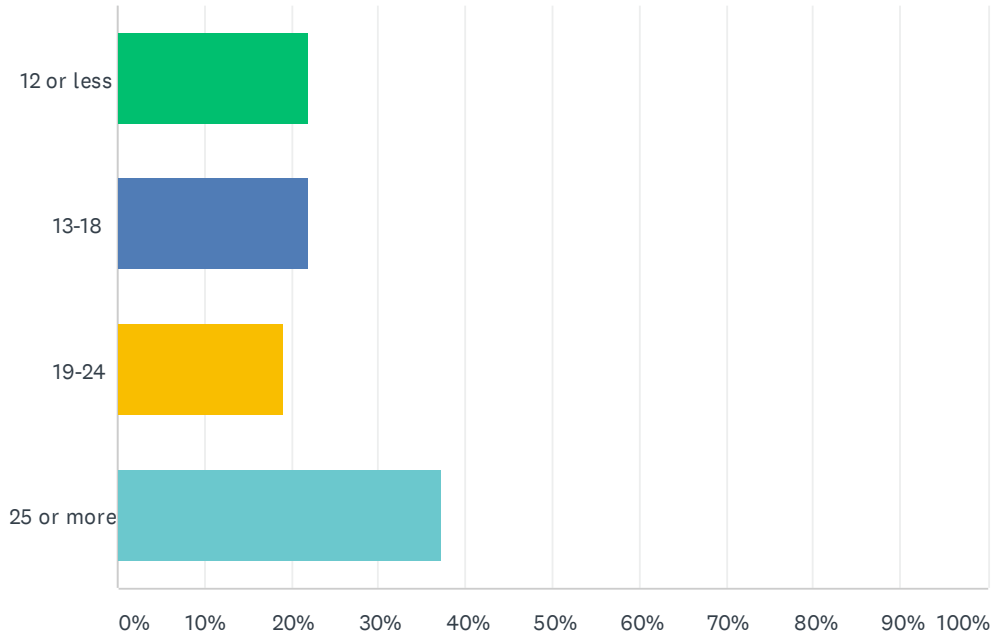

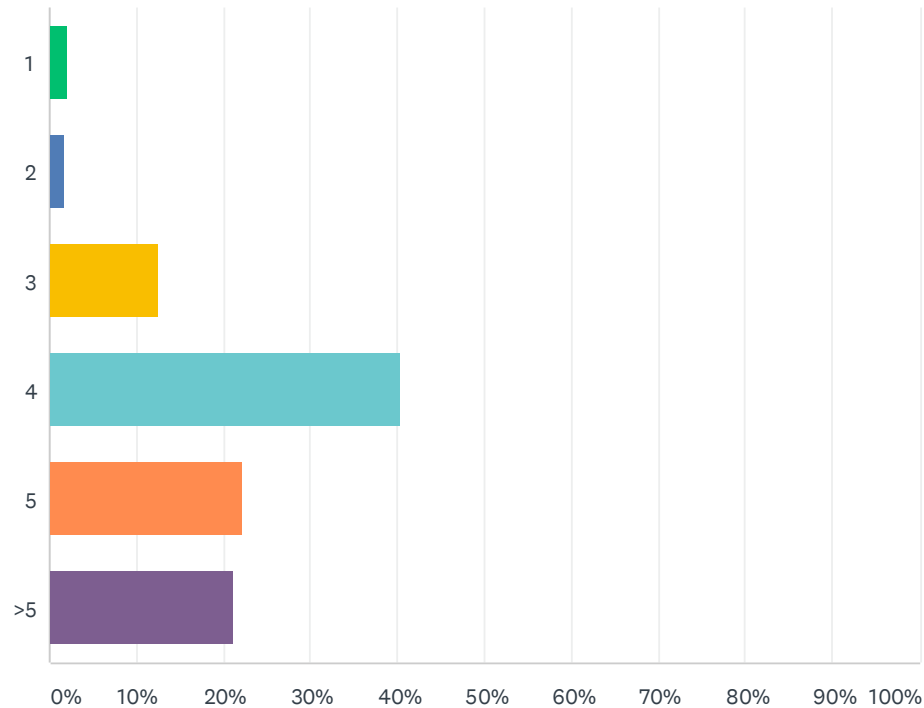

Q8 Considering your experience since July, on average how many hours of didactic sessions are offered in a typical week in your residency? (average number of hours)

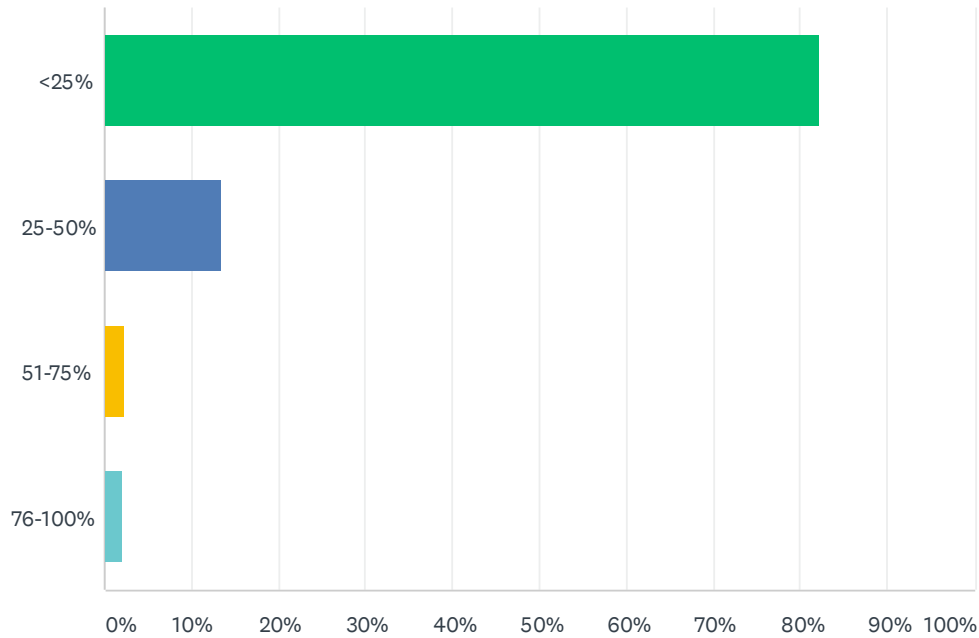

Q9 How are didactic sessions taught? Considering all of your didactic sessions since July, approximately how often was pre-reading or preparation expected?

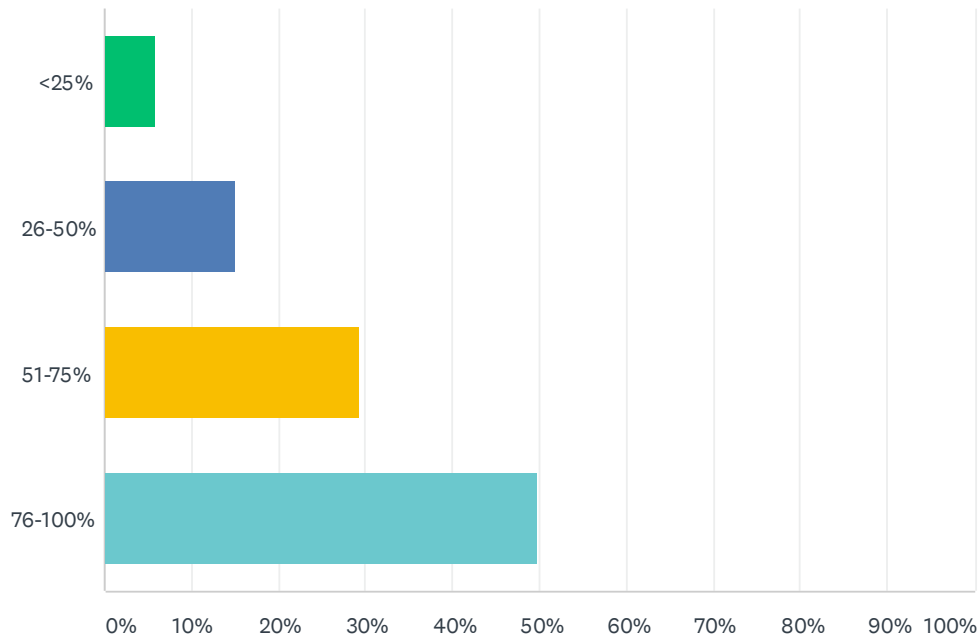

Q10 Considering all scheduled didactic sessions in your residency since July, approximately what percentage were you able to attend?

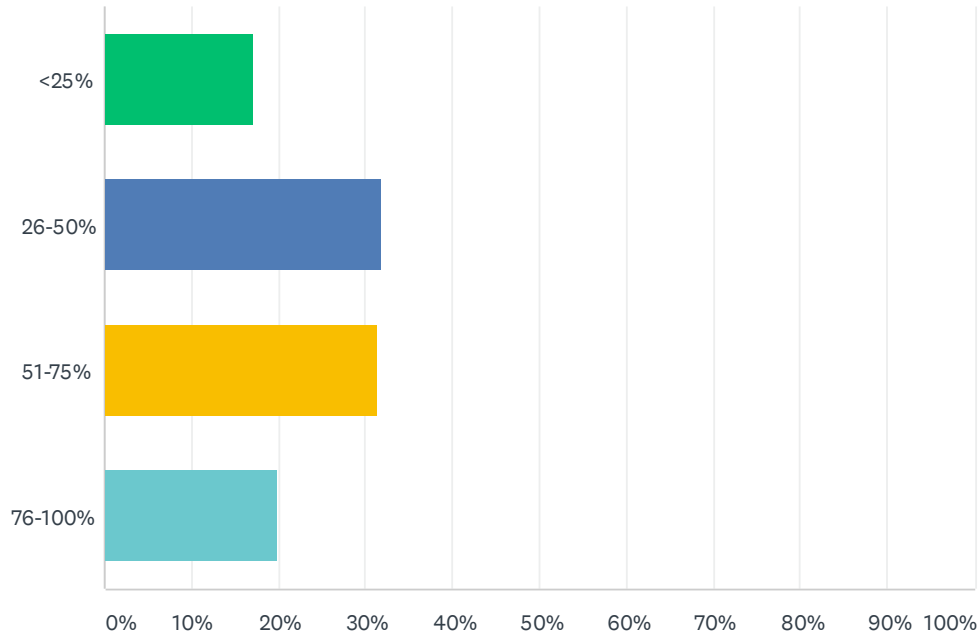

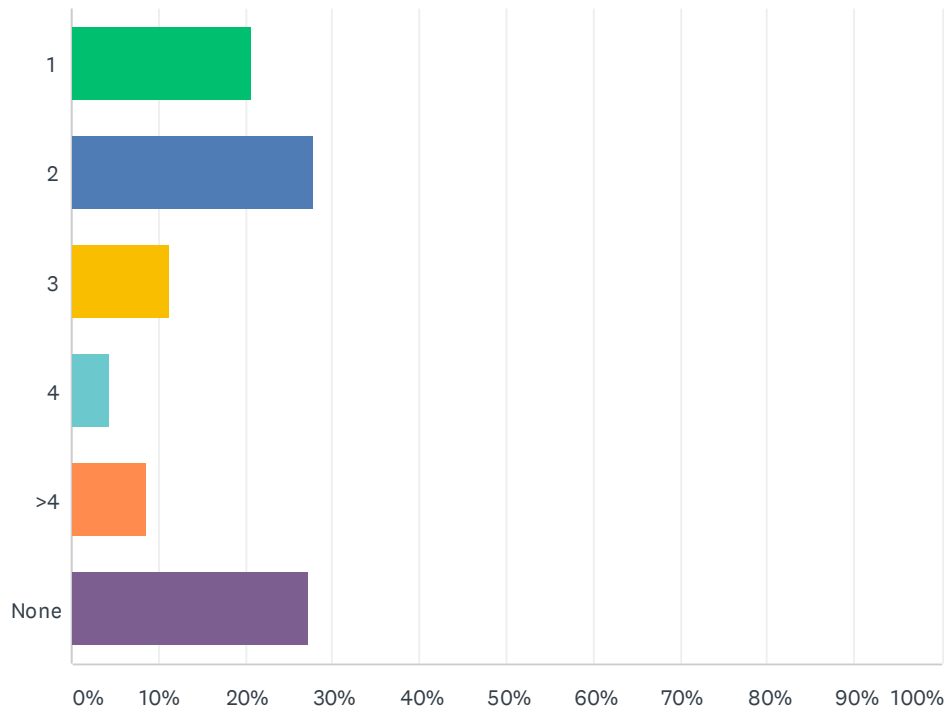

Q12 In the last three months, how often have you personally taught didactic sessions to medical students or residents?

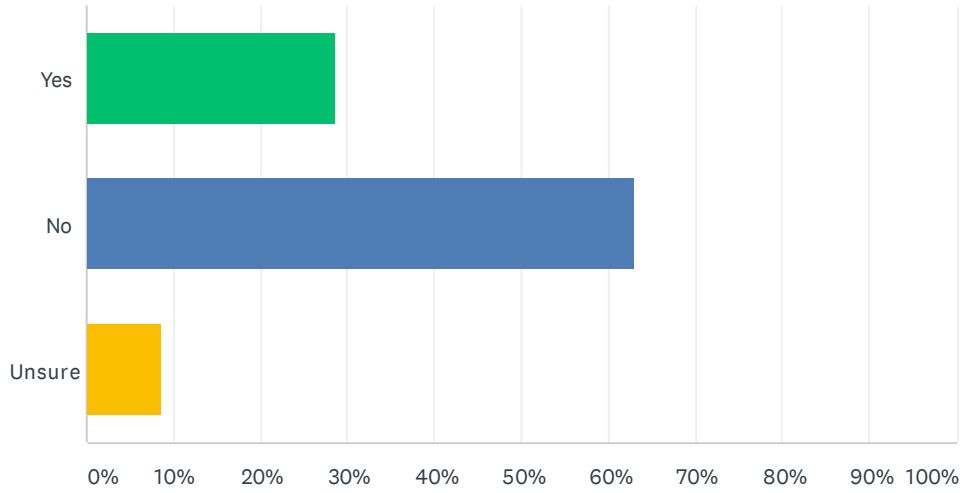

Q13 Have you ever received formal training in how to teach in your residency?

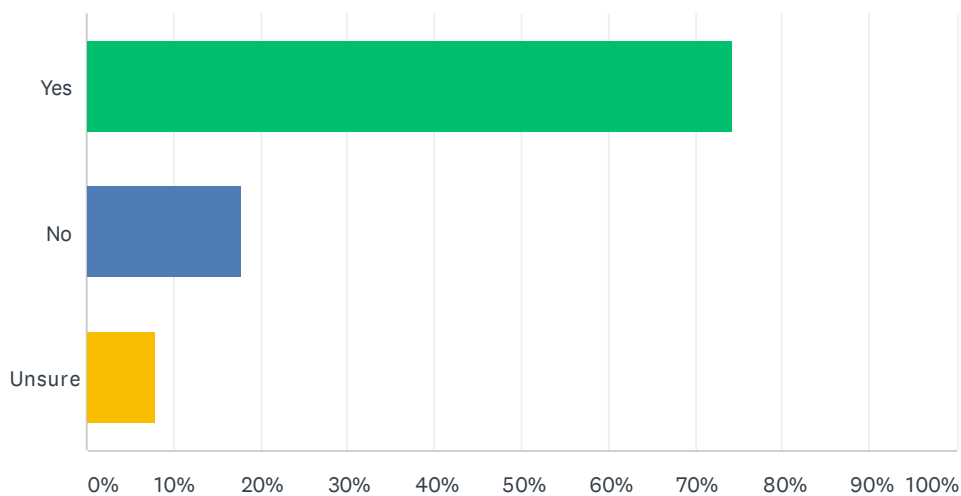

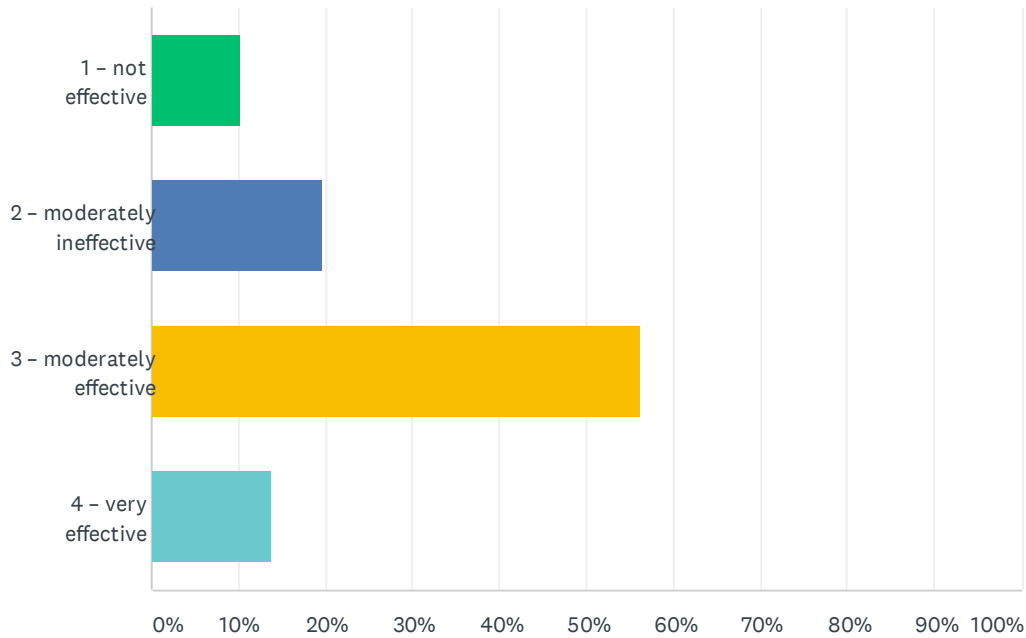

Q15 Considering your experience so far in residency, how effective overall has the process been by which your clinical performance has been reviewed?

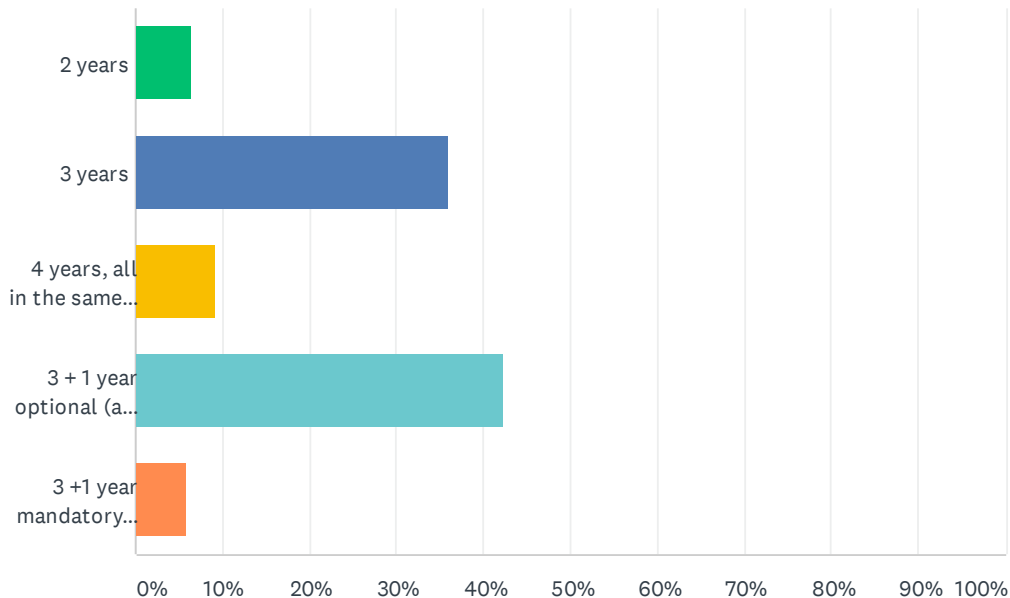

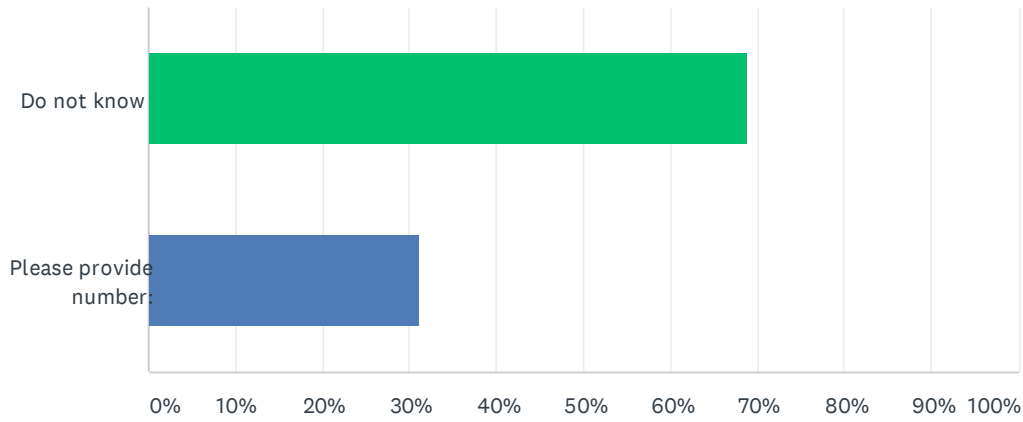

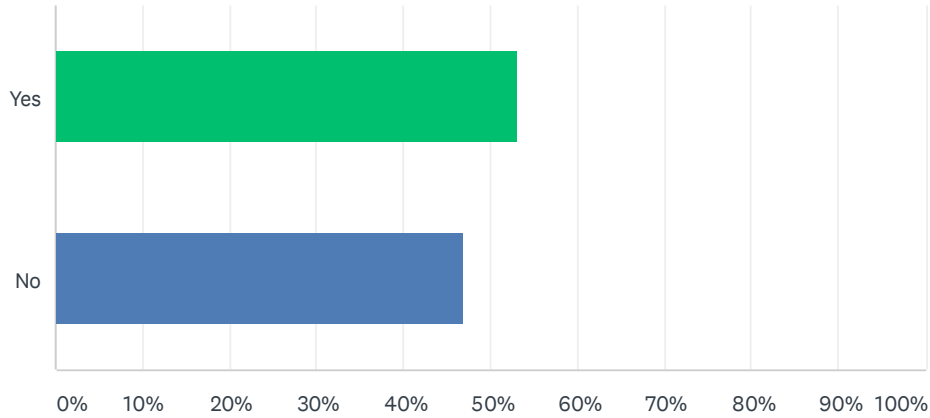

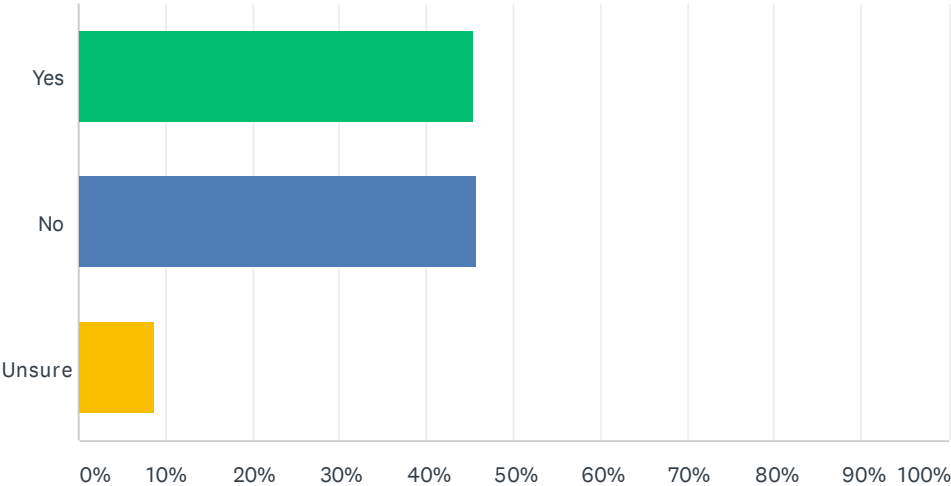

Q19 Have you ever received individual feedback on access to care and/or quality of care for your panel of patients

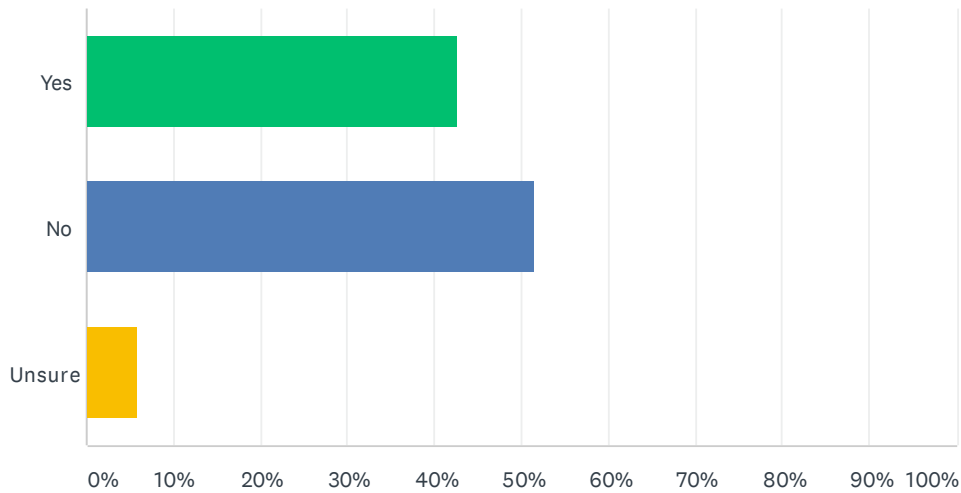

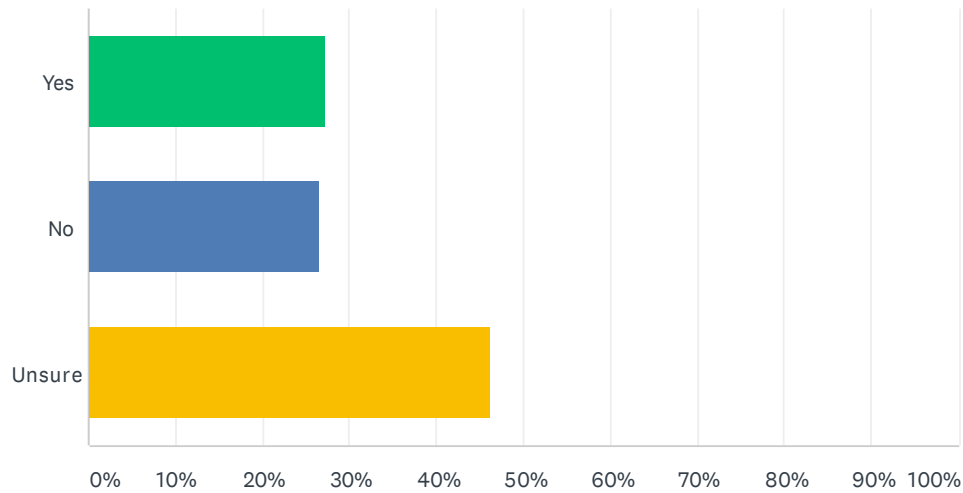

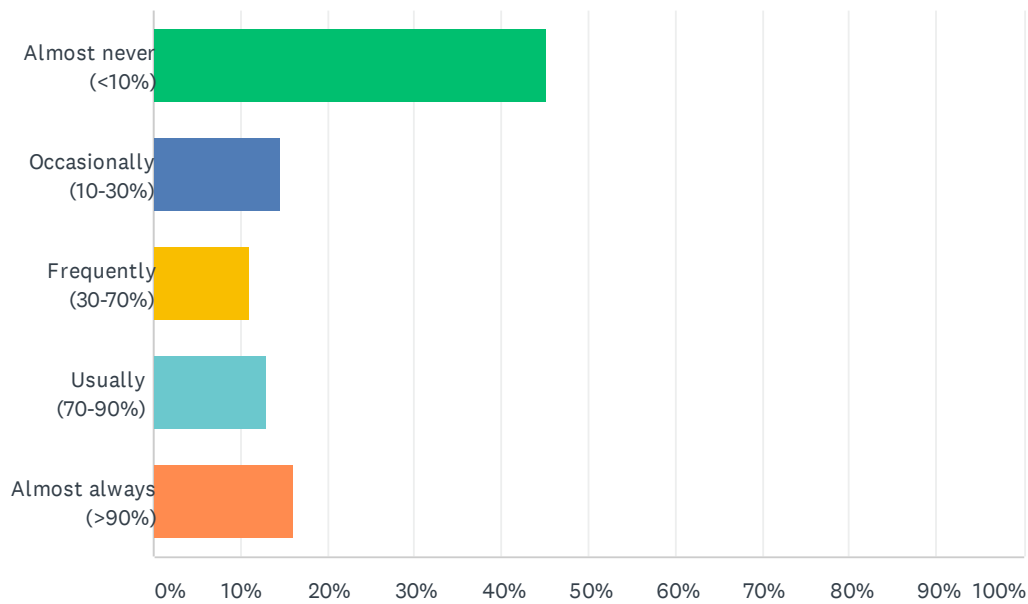

Q22 Over last 3 months, approximately how often have you reviewed with faculty your referrals to other specialist physicians?

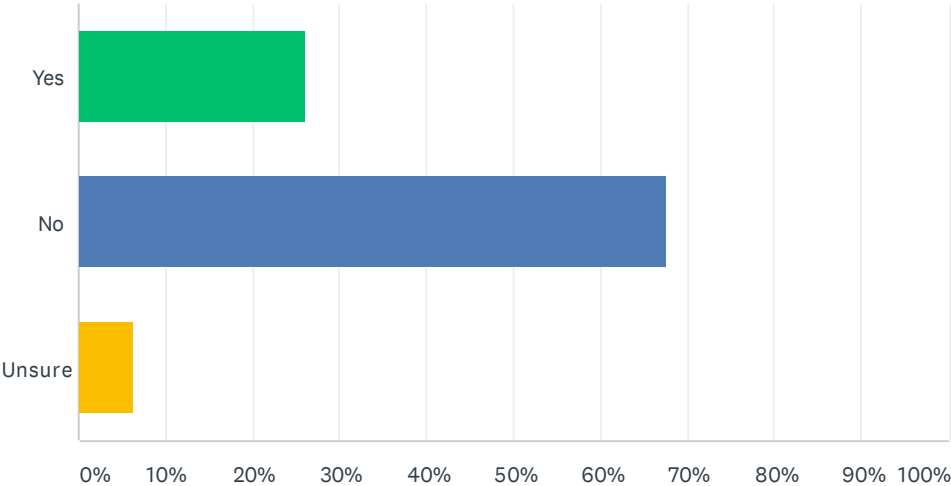

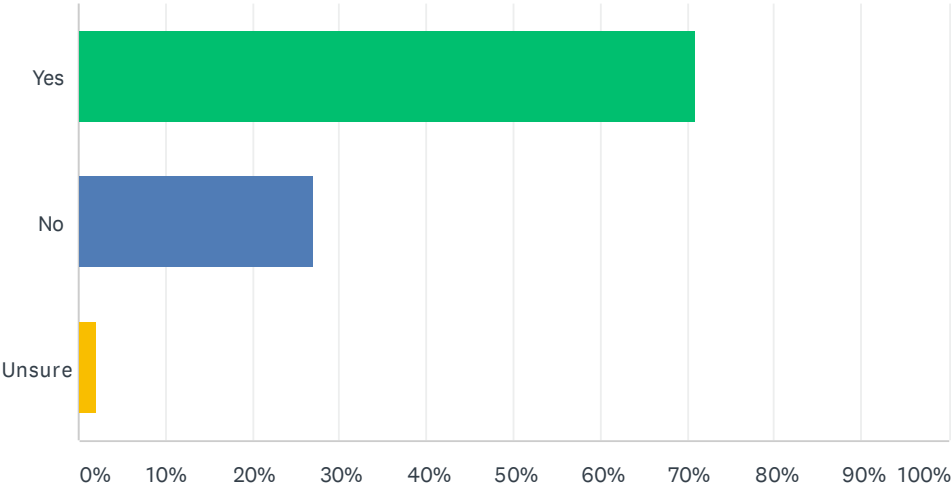

Q24 Have you ever been given individual feedback on billing and coding for the patients you take care of in the family practice center?

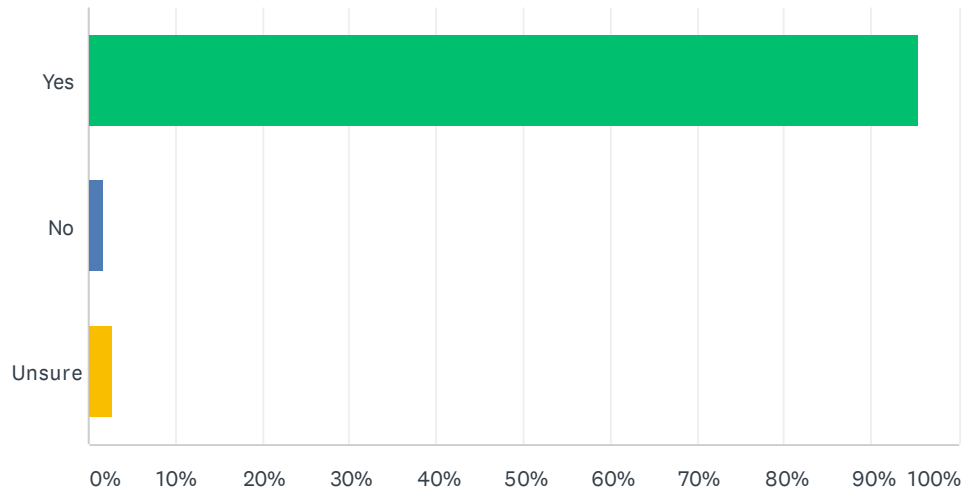

Q25 Does your residency require you to participate in a quality improvement or systems-based learning project of any sort during residency?

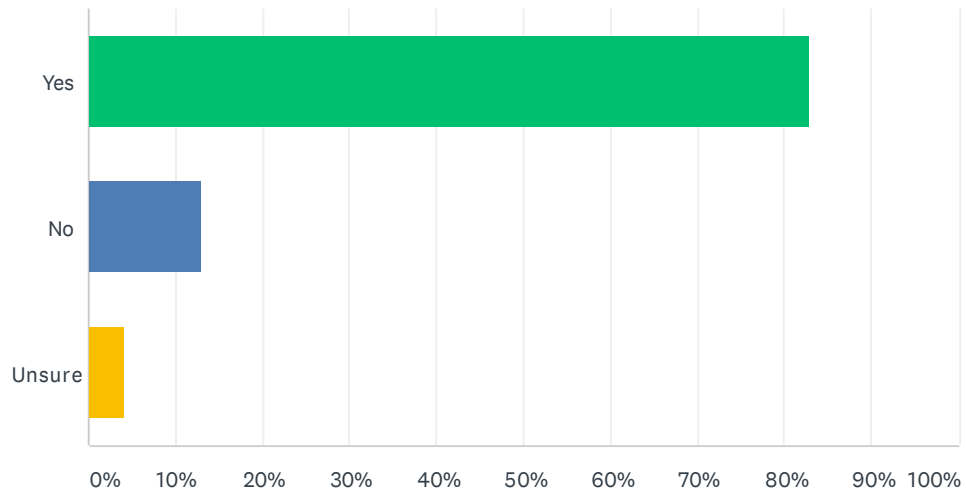

Q26 Did you receive formal education in professionalism in medical school?

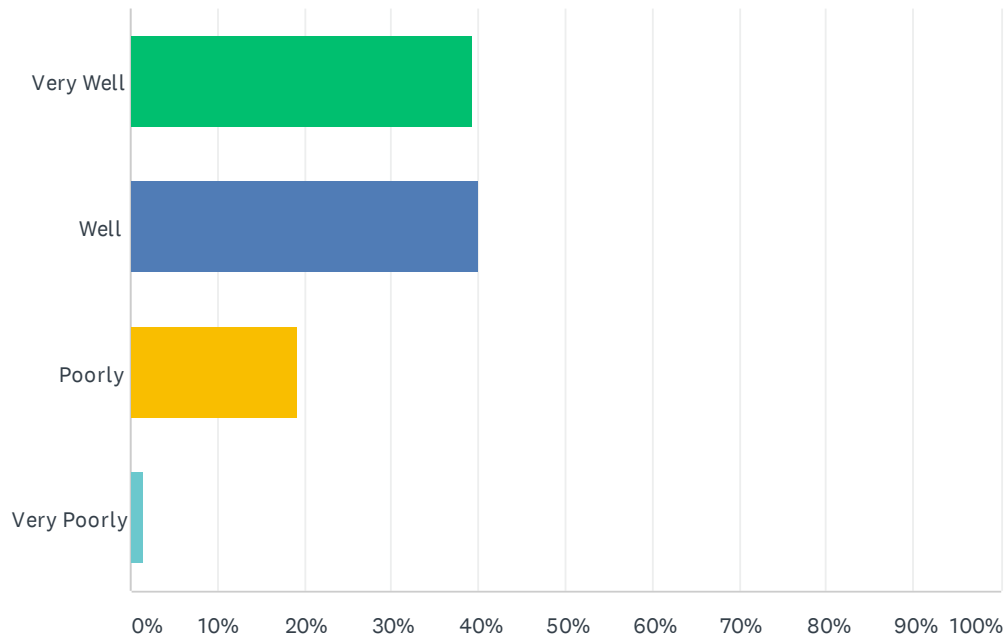

Q27 How well did your medical school provide education in professionalism?

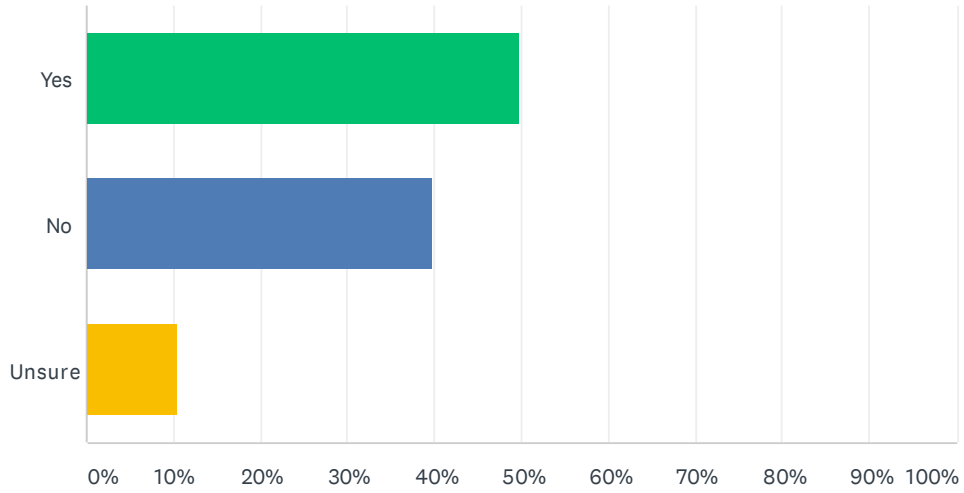

Q28 In your residency so far, have you received any formal education in professionalism?

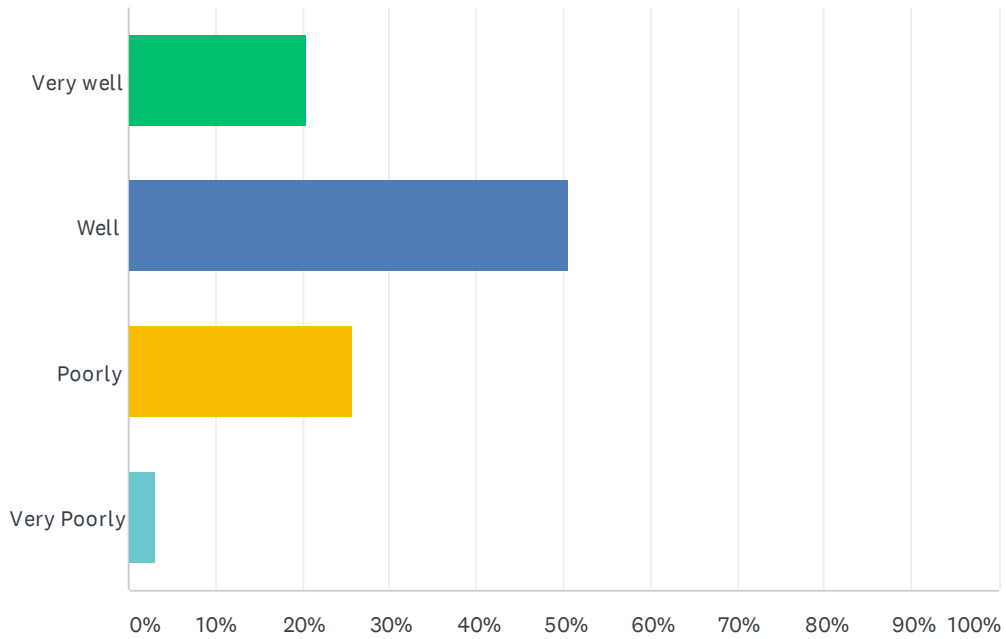

Q29 How well has your residency provided education in professionalism?

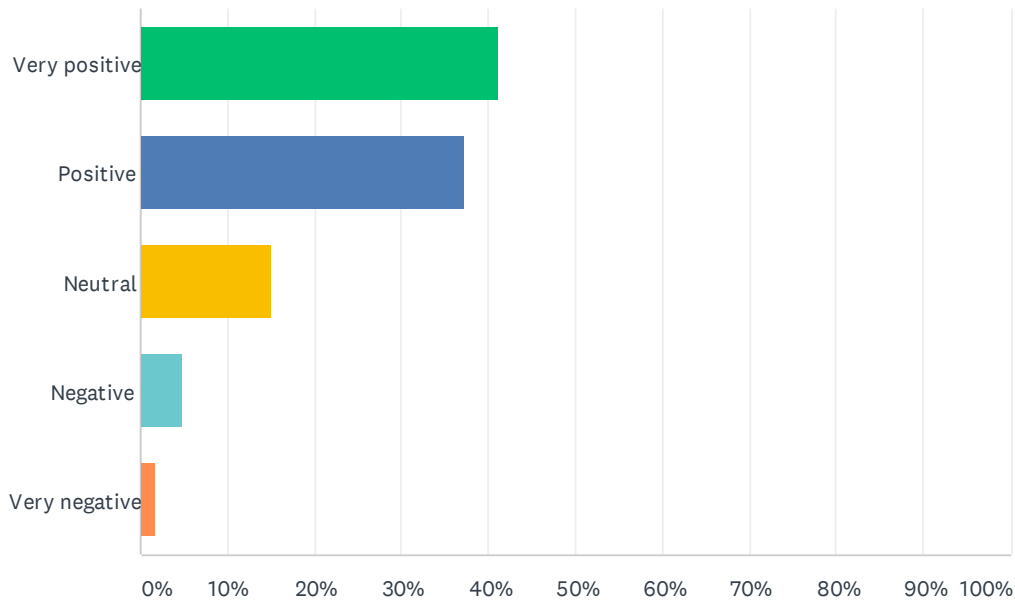

Q30 Overall, how would you characterize your faculty’s role-modeling in professionalism?

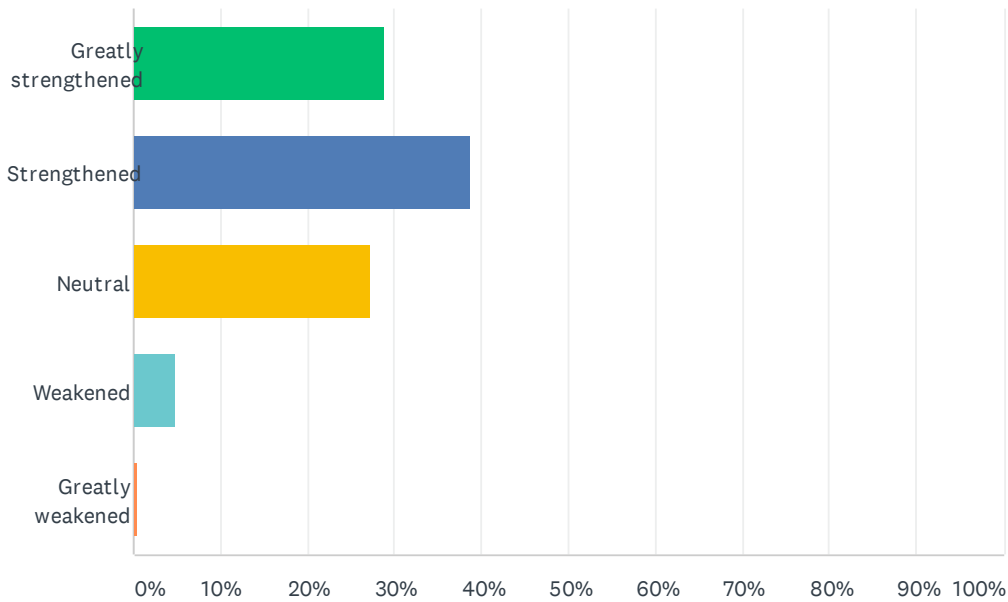

Q31 Overall, how has your residency experience so far affected your sense of professionalism as a family physician?

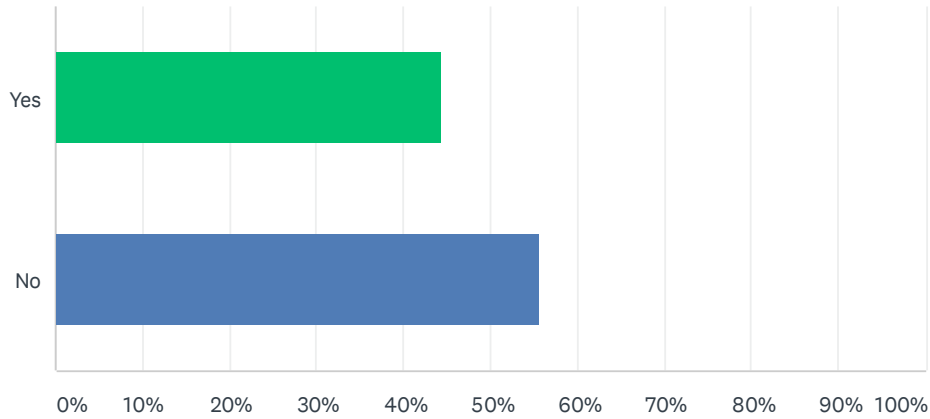

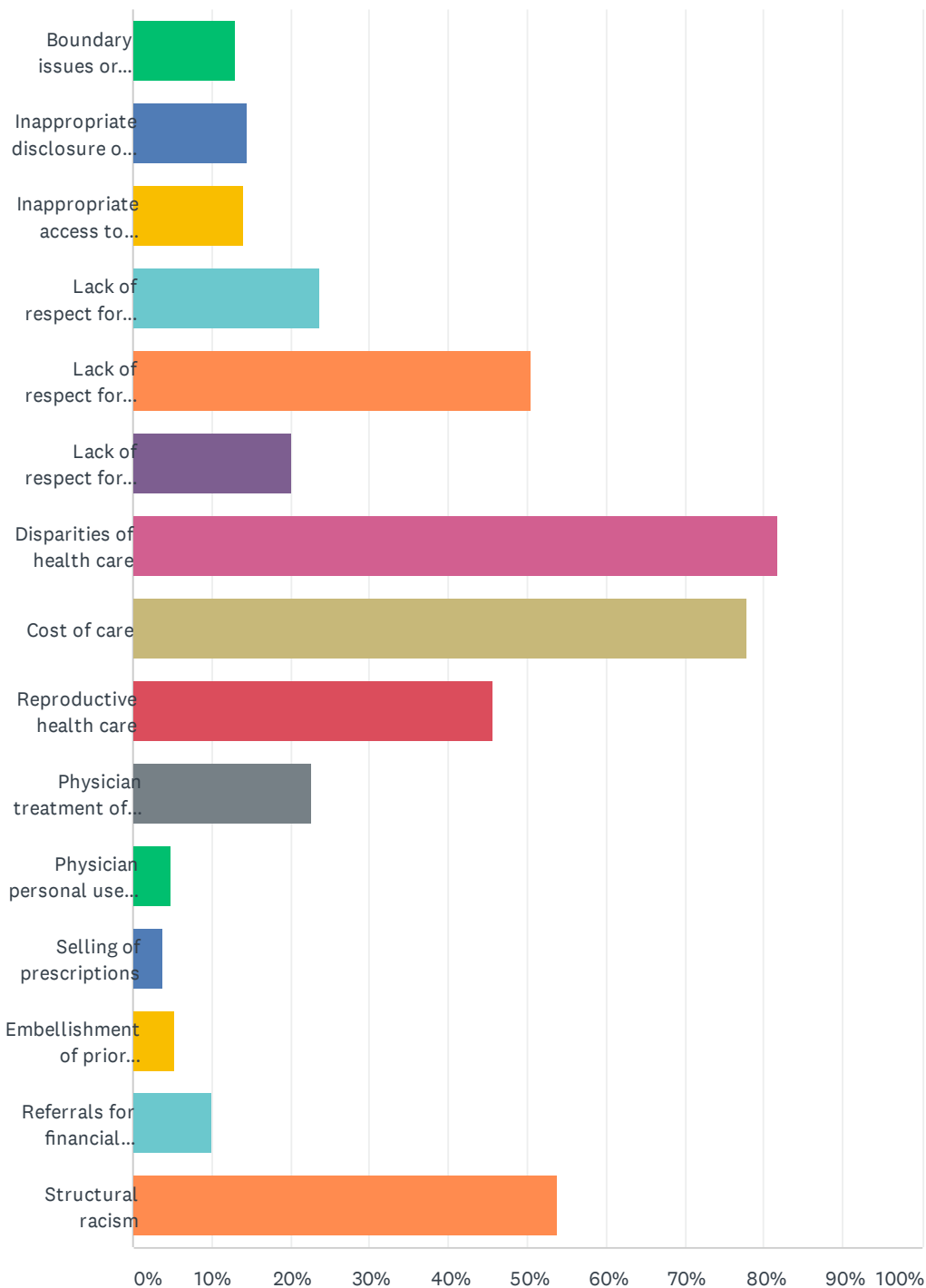

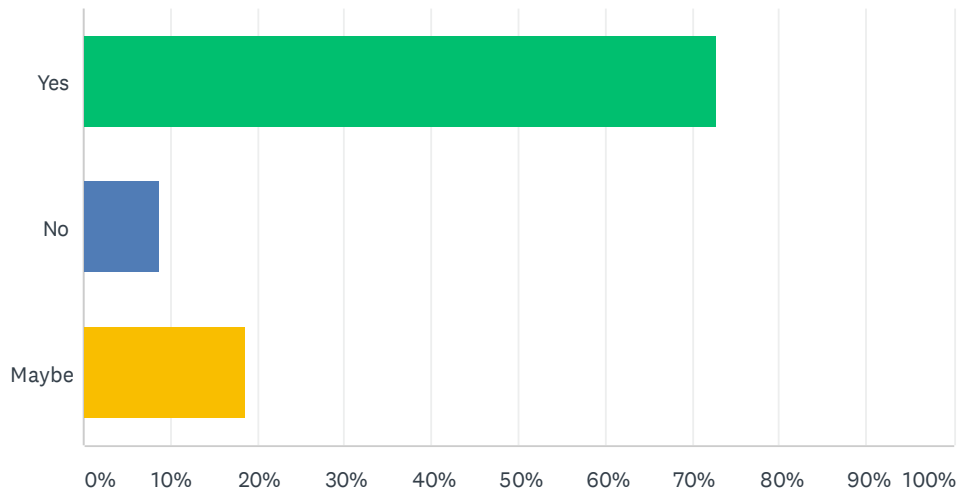

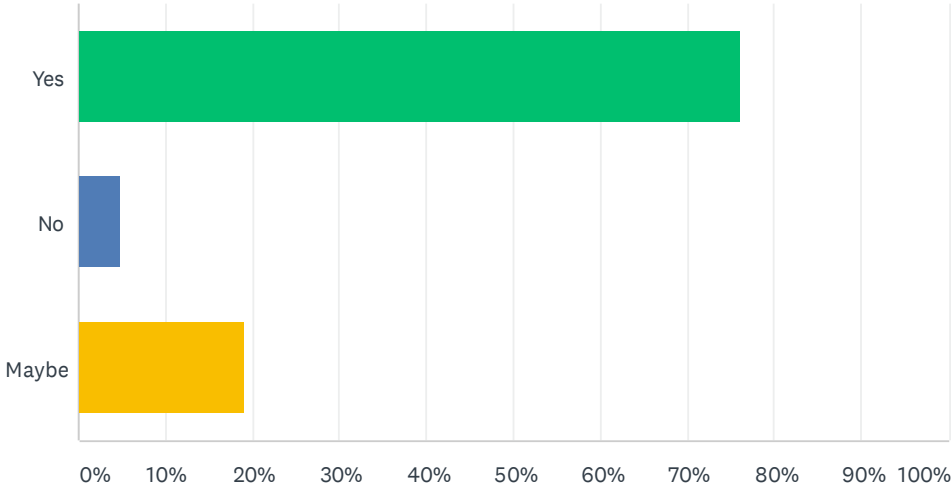

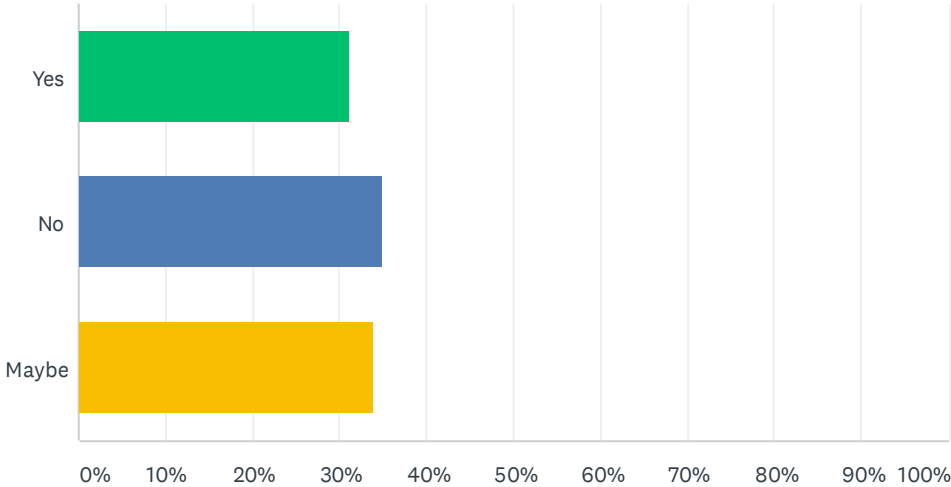

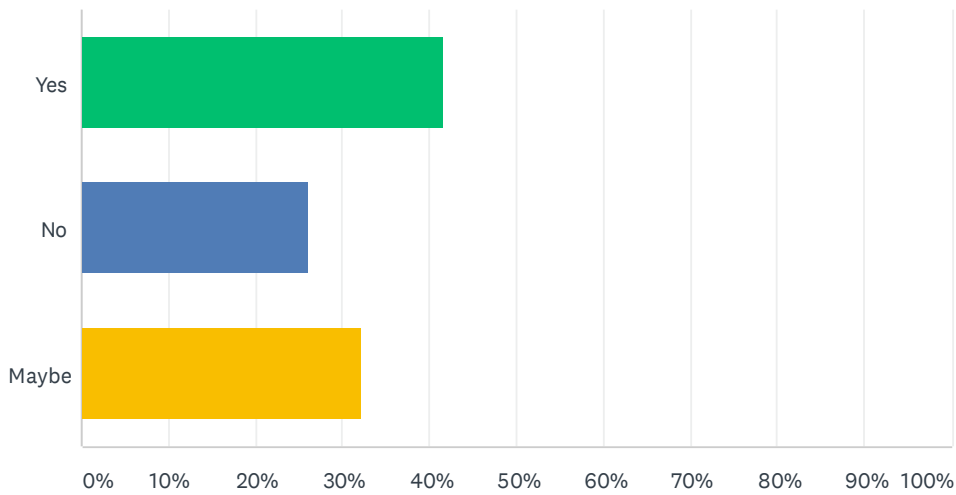

Q37 Are you interested in working in a rural area?

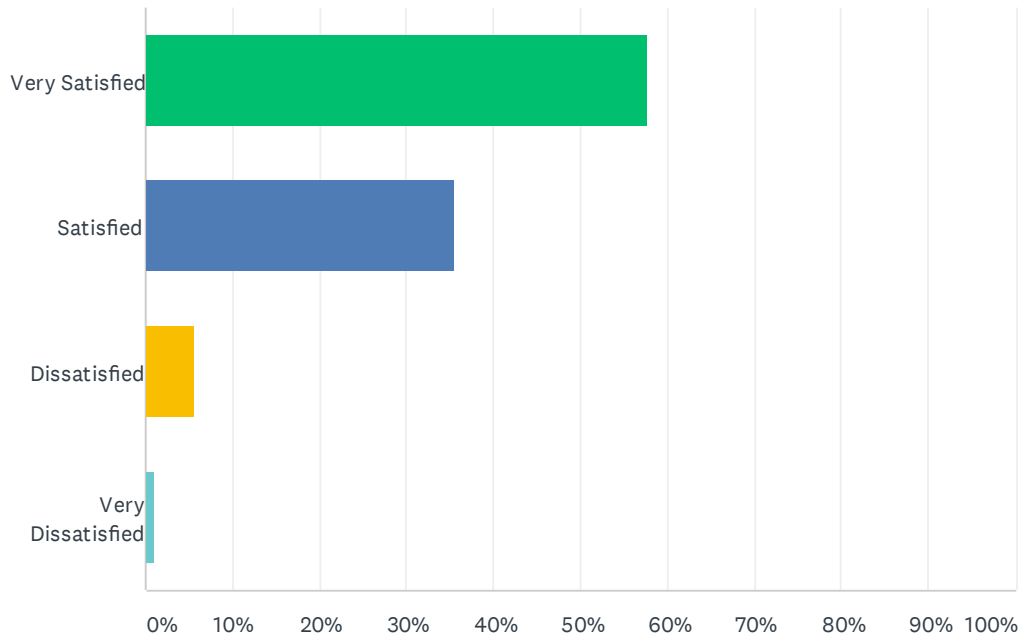
