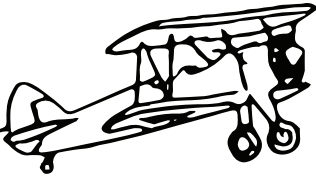

This coloring book is a fun and easy way to engage little ones further in thinking on the creation-Creator connection. It makes a very thoughtful supplement gift to the children's book, Like God. You can bring it in the car, the church pew, share at playdates, Sunday school class, or as a calming break activity at home.

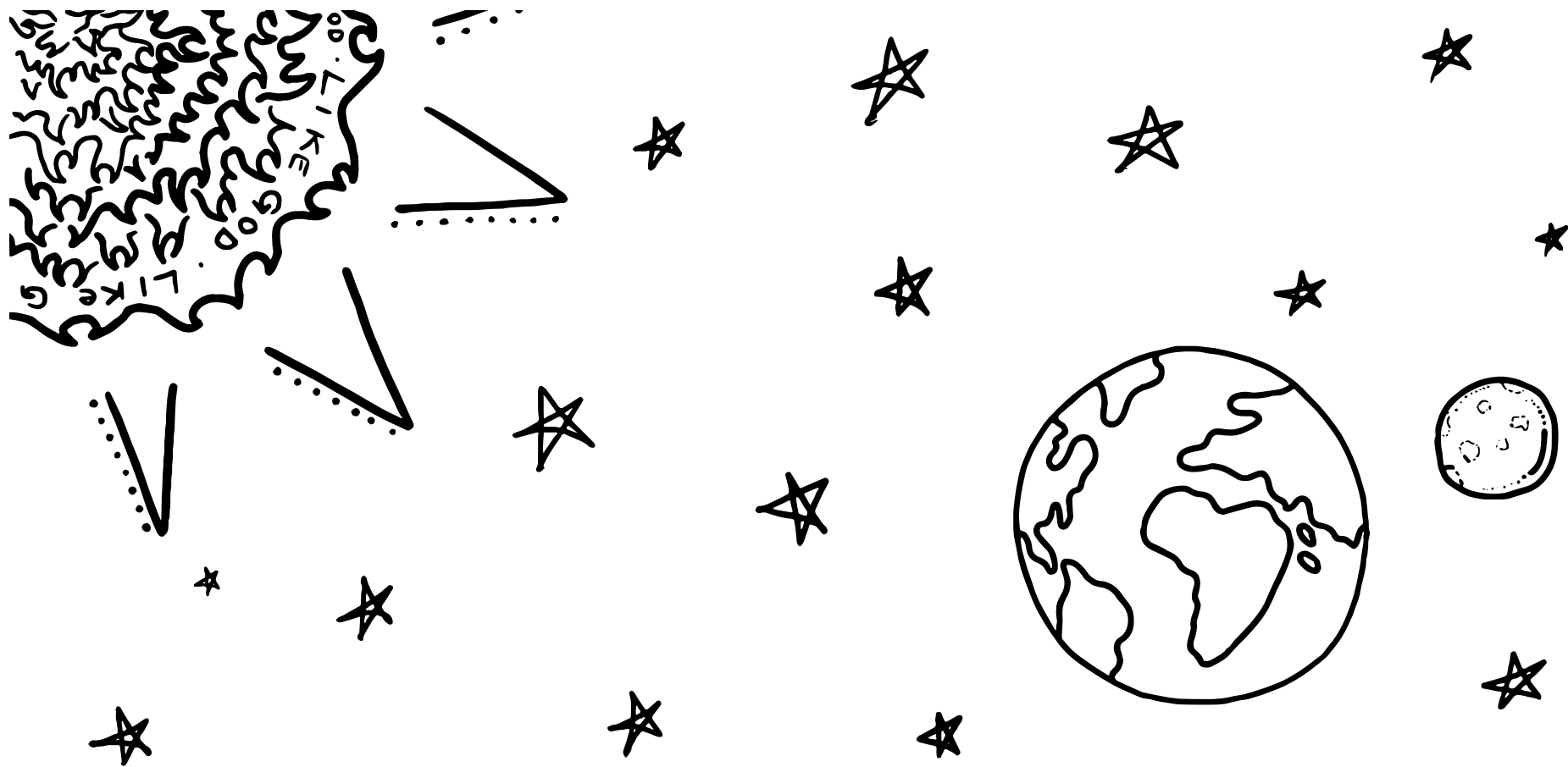
These coloring sheets are particularly dear to my heart, because it was through coloring that the book Like God came to be! Sketching and coloring landscapes at the kitchen table with my six-year-old daughter Moriah, gave the unintended opportunity to reflect on how wonderful God is: "...If the mountain is that mighty, and God made it, what must God be like?" we pondered together.

Like God pages can also be used as devotion prompts:

1. Read Like God the board book together.
2. Then ask your little one, "Which page was your favorite?"
3. Invite them to color that page's correlating color sheet with you
4. As you color (and as age appropriateness allows) ask them thoughtful questions about the Scripture and illustration. "Why was this page your favorite?" "Is this your most favorite thing about God?" "What else is God like?"

Like God (the book and these coloring sheets) is meant to point our hearts toward worship of the one in whom "we live, move, and have our being" (Acts 17:28). The one, who is mindful of us, cares for us, and has crowned us as image bearers just below the heavenly beings (Psalm 8). The one who the heavens declare as glorious (Psalm 19).

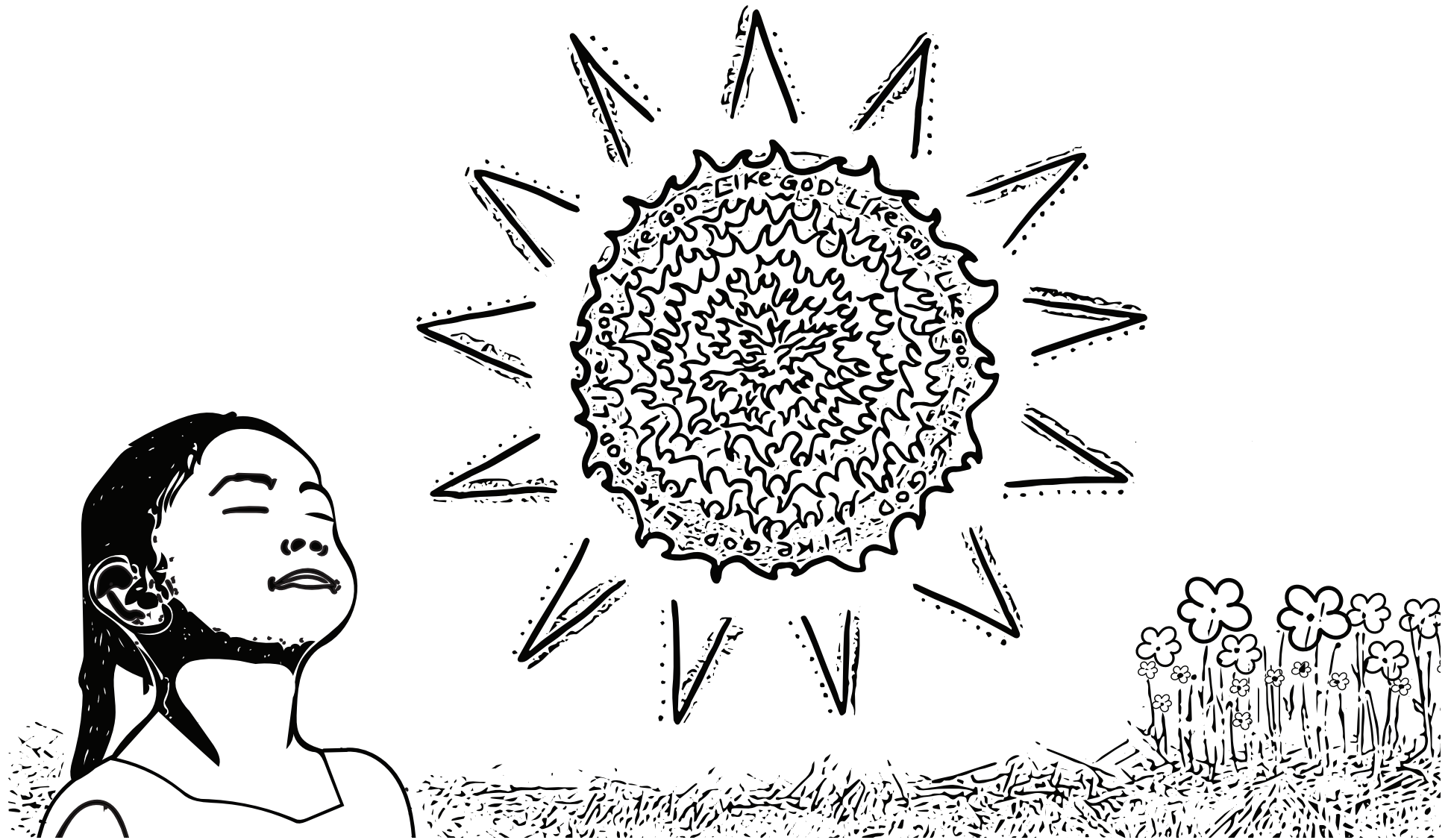
May each page fill you and your little one with more and more worship of God, as you ponder all that he has made, and all that he is.

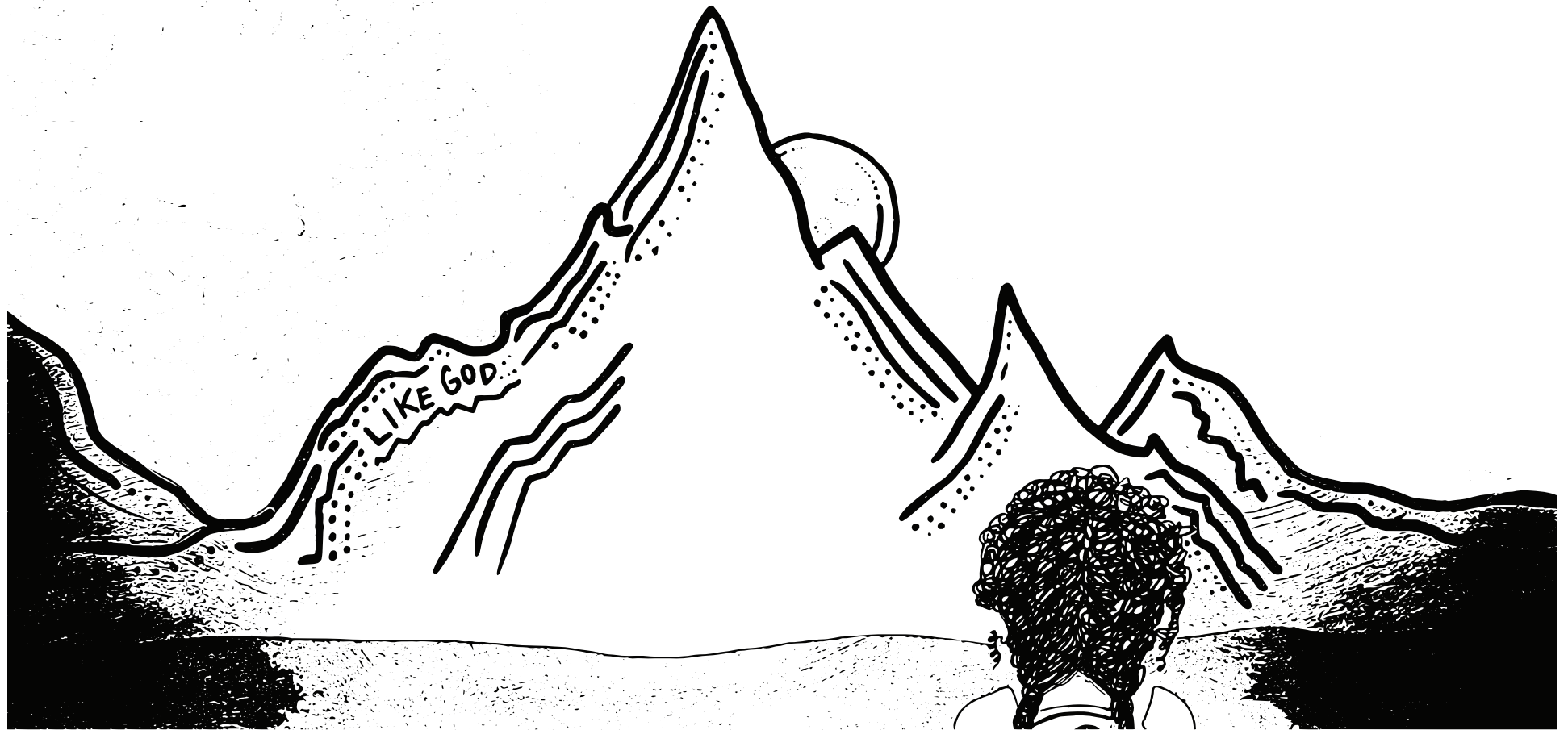




# THE SUN

the LORD on high is majestic. Psalm 93:4



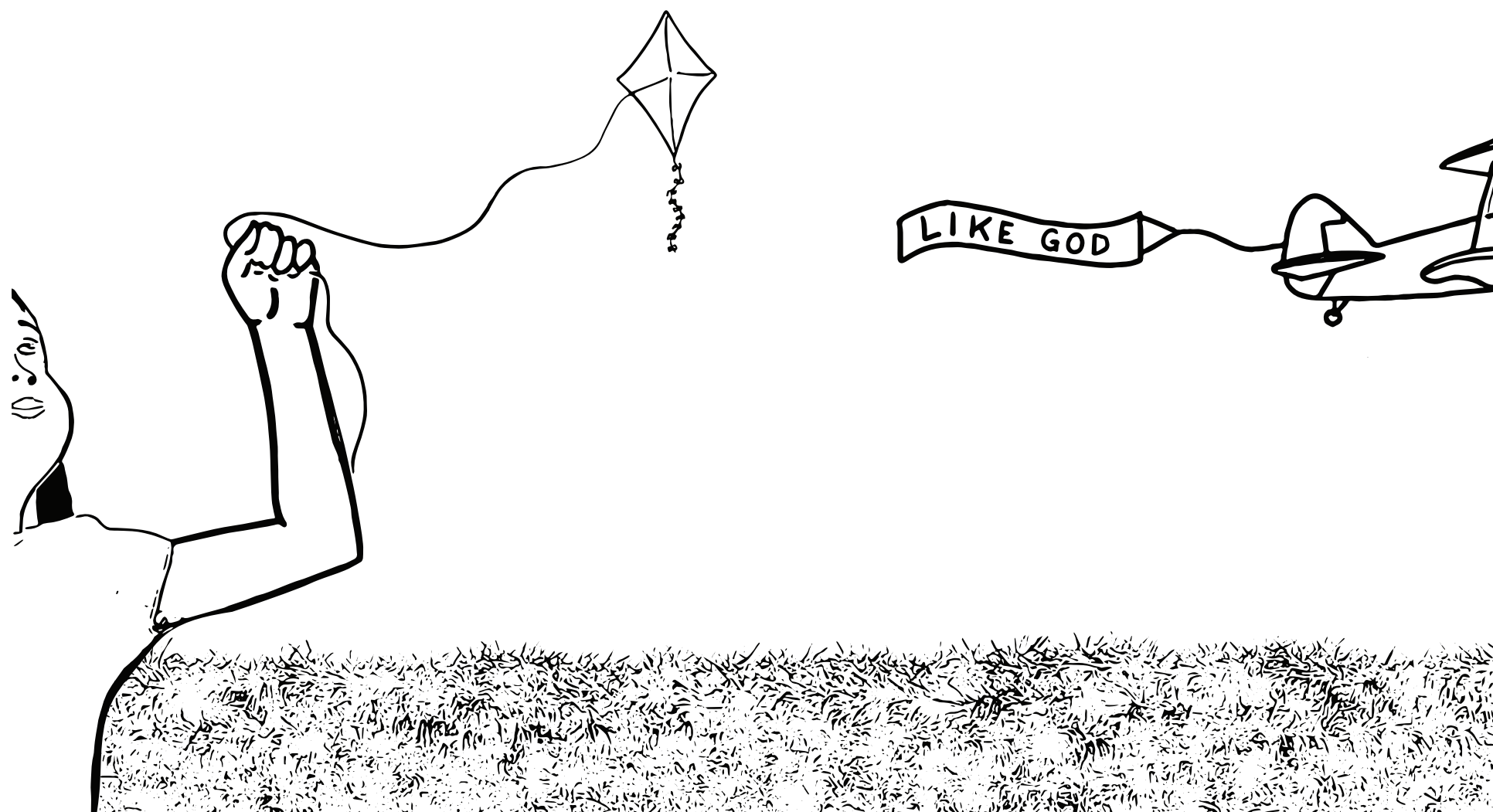


# THE FOREST

son of man that you care for him? Psalm 8:3-4



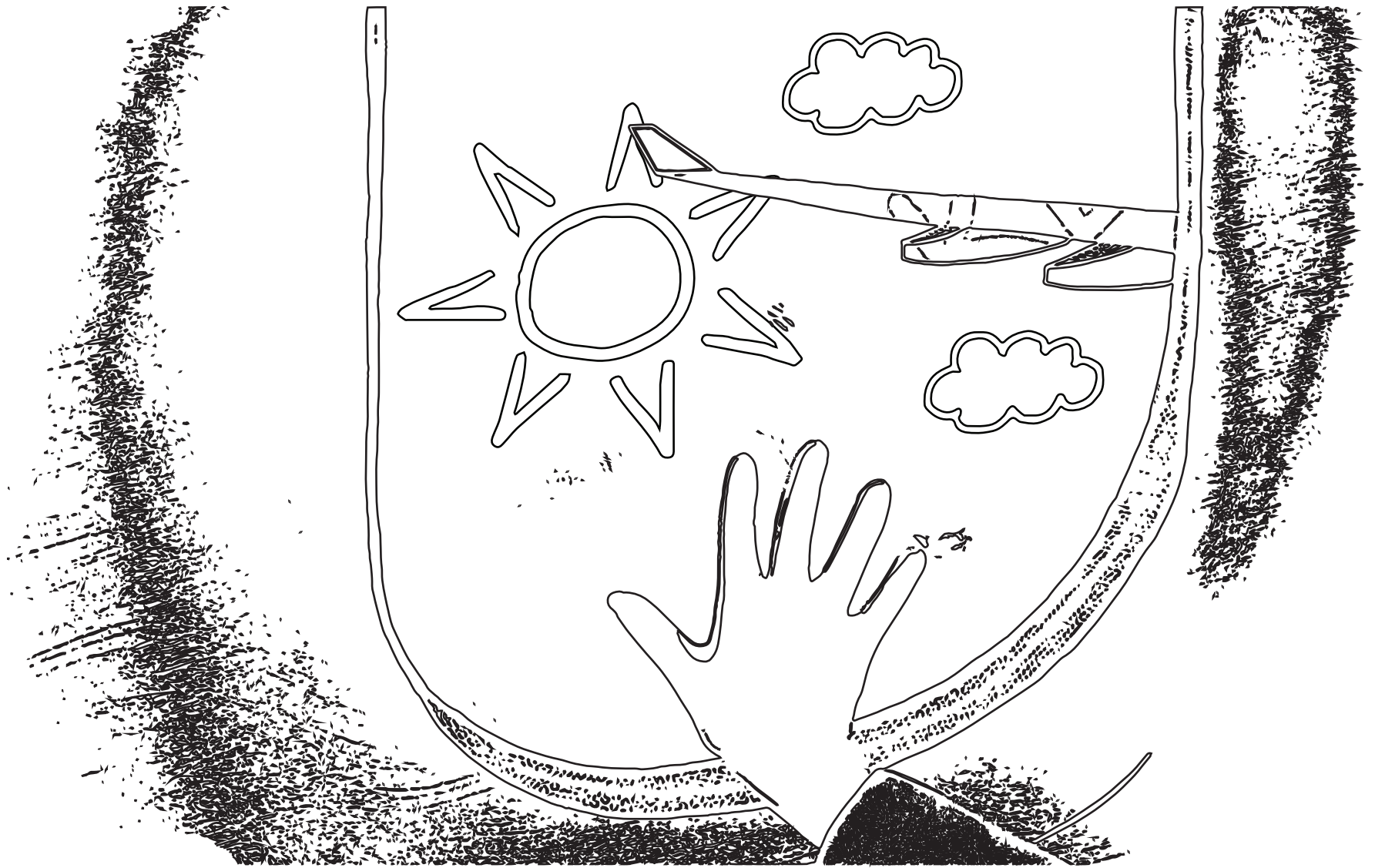




## THE RAIN

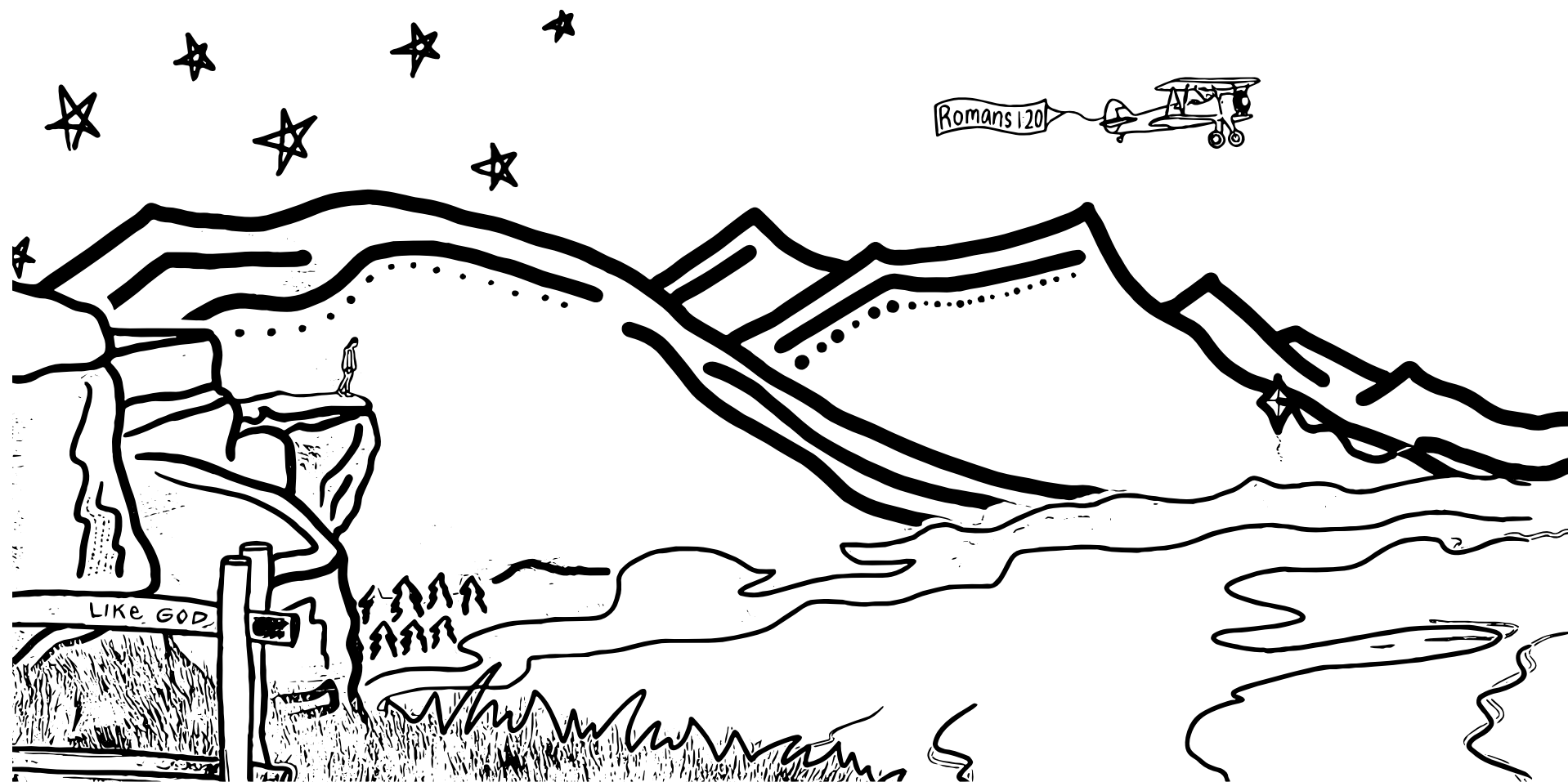
