This document outlines the responsibilities and expectations between the provider (Dymocks Children's Charities Limited) and the recipient of the Library Regeneration Program.

The Library Regeneration Program restocks school libraries and other important support centres with brand new books of choice. The beneficiary selects brand new books from a carefully curated catalogue of quality titles to ensure they receive the books most suitable for the needs of their pupils and their curriculum.

The provider agrees to:

1. Inform recipient of the program amount
2. Provide books, as chosen by the recipient

The recipient agrees to:

1. Adhere to the program delivery timeline, by
 - placing your online order within two weeks from receiving the program offer email unless otherwise agreed.
 - providing photos of children / students with their new books (if appropriate) with signed media permission form within two weeks from the bulk of the books being delivered.
2. Ensure that the books supplied are available to the children/ students for the purpose of the program
3. Not to sell or give away the books to obtain a profit
4. If you do receive a feedback form / questionnaire from Dymocks Children's Charities, please return this within 10 business days

Please note

- *Books are delivered in batches according to their distributor, therefore they will not all arrive at the same time*
- *The provider reserves its right to select replacement titles if the publisher is unable to provide the titles selected by the recipient due to factors outside of the provider and publisher's control*
- *Please note that there may be a delay in books selected by the provider being delivered within the estimated delivery time frame due to unforeseen distribution issues*
