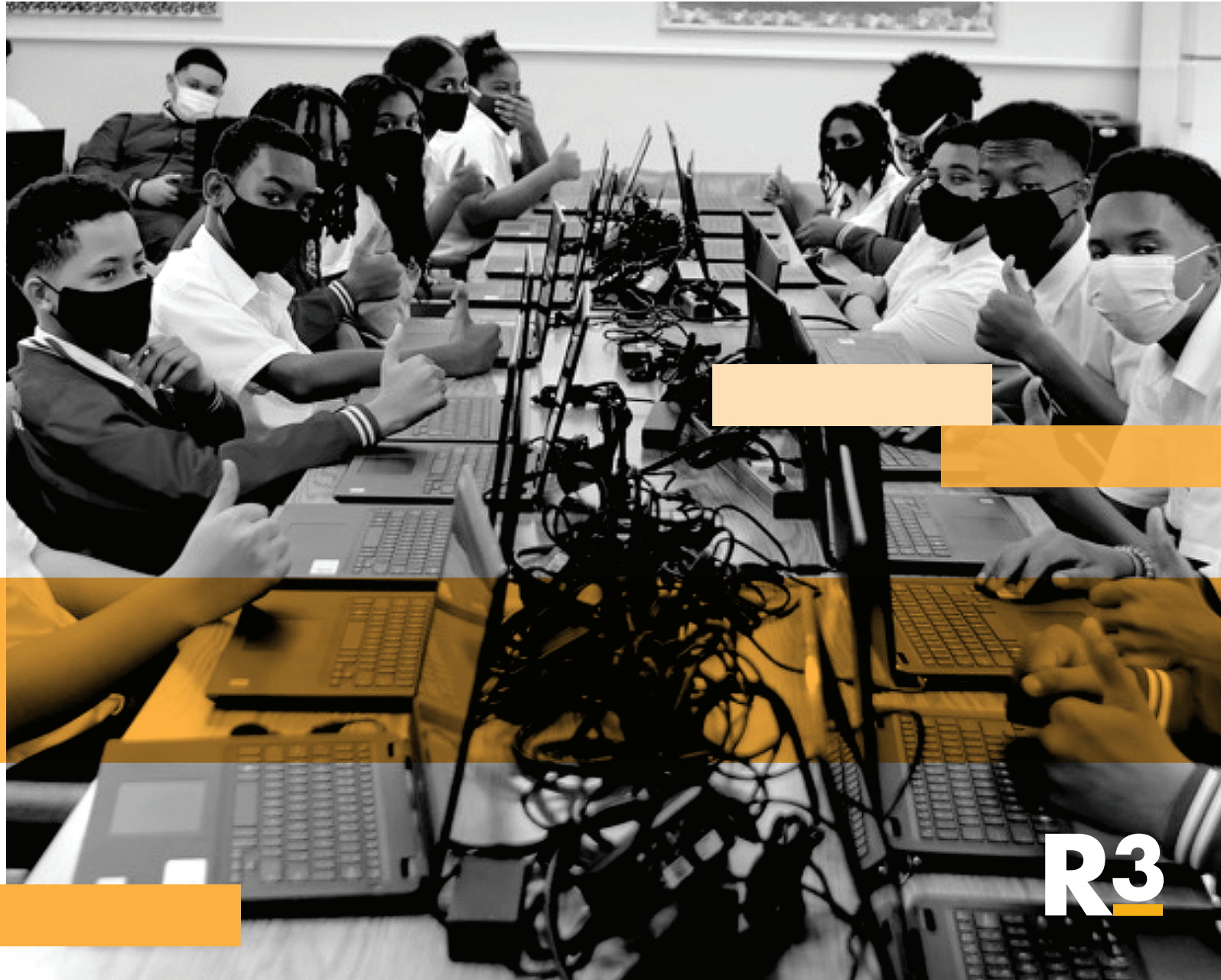

What We Do

In response to the hardship caused by the COVID-19 pandemic, R3 Cayman Foundation was established as a charitable organisation focused on Readiness, Relief and Recovery in the Cayman Islands

Readiness

Investing in preventative measures that safeguard against natural and man-made emergencies and disasters.

Relief

Supporting the provision of basic needs in the wake of an emergency or disaster

Recovery

Aiding initiatives that stimulate the local economy and recovery of the natural environment following an emergency or disaster.



Community. Integrity. Vision.

The Board of Directors reviews applications on the merits of the proposal alongside the financial standing, governance and administration protocols of the applicant.

The evaluation process considers:

- non-profit sector research
- population needs analysis
- risk assessments
- measurable deliverables
- community impact



Our Giving Philosophy

- If an area of need is already being filled, R3 will provide support to non-profit organisations
- If an area of need is not being served, R3 will support directly with funding or by teaming up with another service provider

MARCH 2020

Resilience Cayman Housing Repairs Programme

CI\$1.5 million grant from the Ministry of Investment, Innovation and Social Development, R3 partnered with Resilience Cayman on a housing repair programme for Caymanian homeowners

Alex Panton Foundation

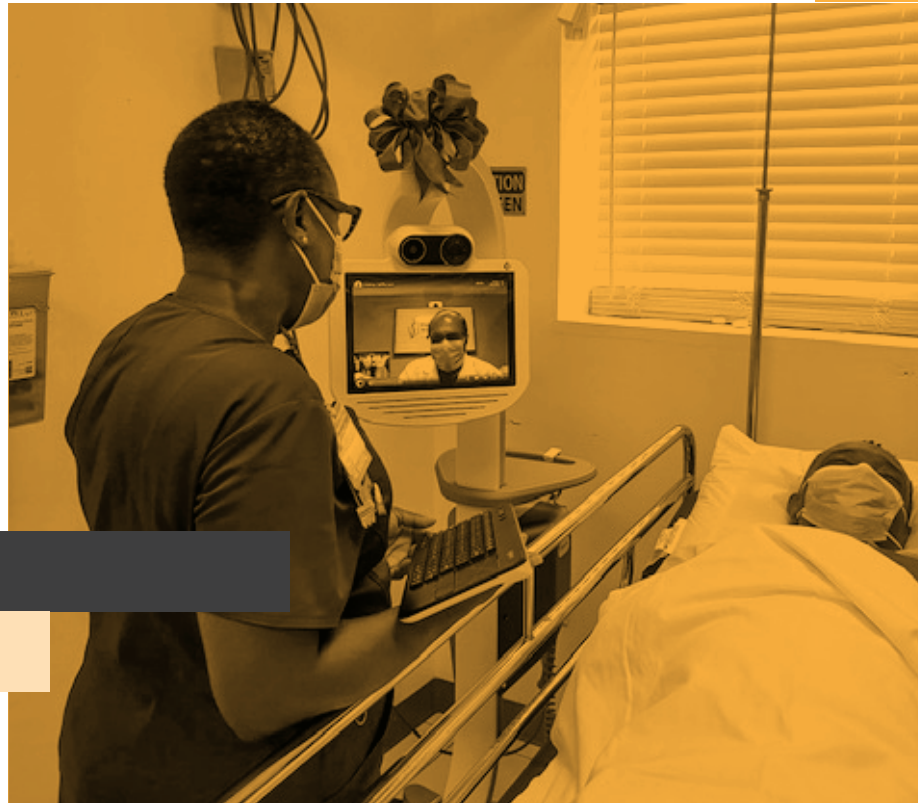
R3's donation to the Alex Panton Foundation's Financial Assistance Programme assisted 45 applicants in receiving urgent care.



Case Study: Readiness

Health Services Authority – Telemedicine for Little Cayman

R3 provided funding to allow for remote medical consultations from Little Cayman utilizing an intouch Teladoc robot to replicate the benefits of a face-to-face exam.
