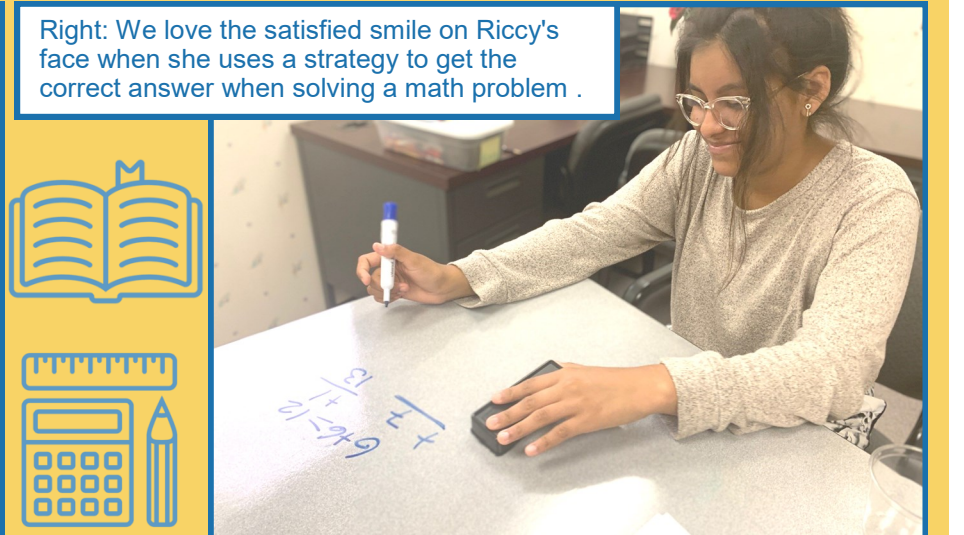

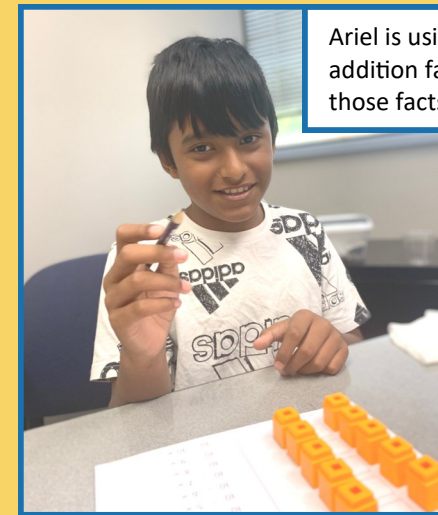
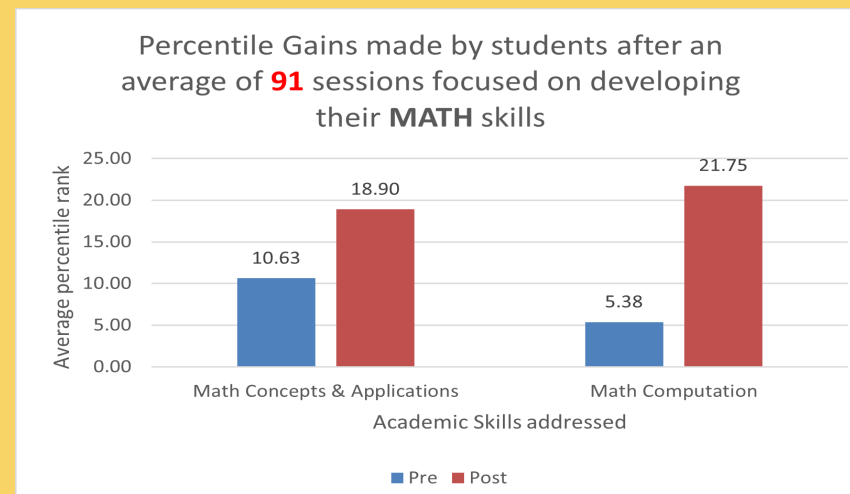
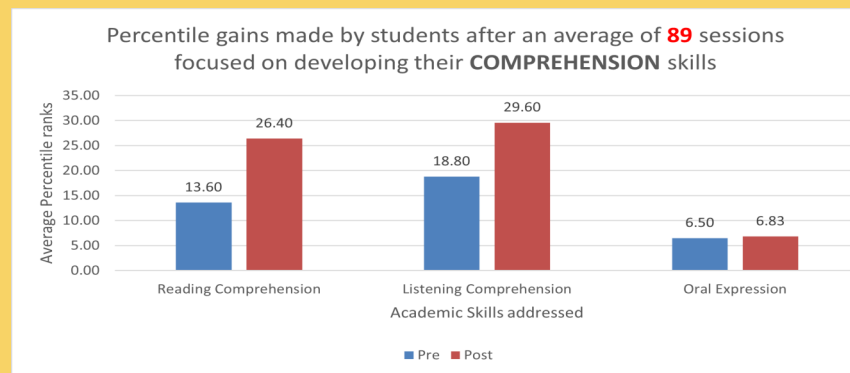
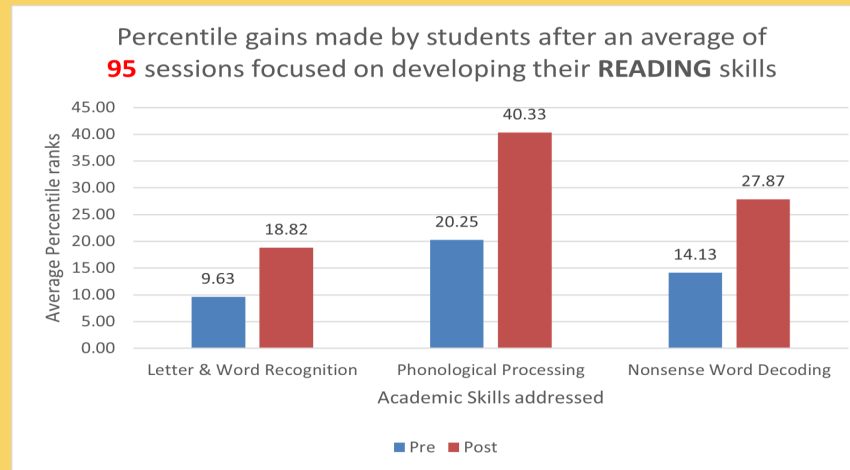
Becca is working hard to improve her reading and spelling skills. You can see her eyes looking up as she is imaging the letters of the word she is attempting to spell.

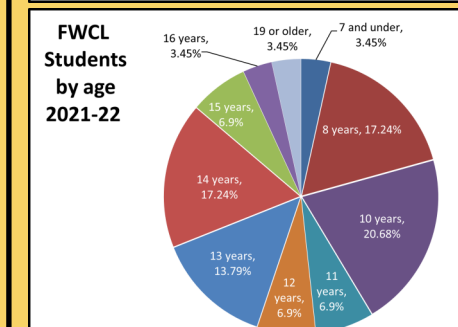
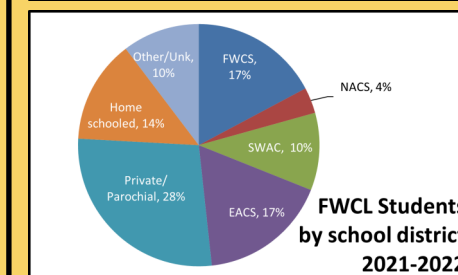
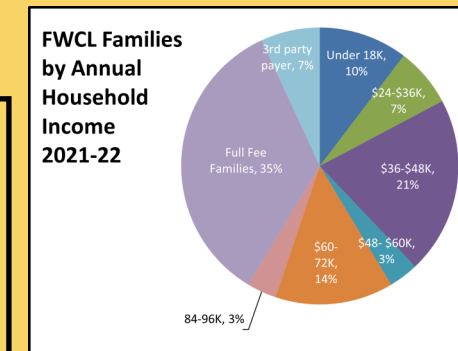
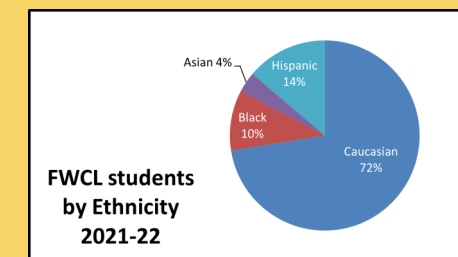
## A RE-CAP OF FY2021-22

- ◆ We were still in the midst of the Covid-19 pandemic.
- ◆ Samantha Kugler was promoted to Director of Instruction in September.
- ◆ The Festival of Sports was a non-event again and raised \$15,262.
- ◆ A PPP Loan in the amount of \$34,775, secured in FY2020-21, was fully forgiven.
- ◆ The Center was awarded a surprise \$5,000 grant from the Community Foundation of Greater Fort Wayne for having raised the most money for their endowment fund during the Giving Tuesday Fort Wayne Challenge in November.
- ◆ The Center took advantage of Employee Retention Credits being offered during the pandemic and received \$69,718.
- ◆ The Brain Game was once again a virtual event and raised \$10,413. The Master Minds team won.
- ◆ In April, the Center participated in Give Greater Allen County and raised \$5,060 in donations and matching monies in one day.
- ◆ Board President, Sherri Chaney, termed off the Board after 6 years of service. We thank her for all her work on behalf of FWCL.
- ◆ FWCL staff attended the annual Conference on Youth in October (we were also a vendor) as well as an array of staff development opportunities throughout the year that were held virtually.

## FACTS & FIGURES

- ◆ 29 students (17 boys & 12 girls) received instruction
- ◆ 27 were from Allen County, 1 from Noble County and 1 from Wells County
- ◆ Academic Assessments were administered to 30 students
- ◆ 93% of students were private pay clients
- ◆ Financial assistance was given to 63% of them and the remaining 37% were full fee clients
- ◆ 7% of students were contracted through the Department of Child Services
- ◆ Tuition Assistance in the amount of \$75,239 was provided to 17 families.
- ◆ Additional Kunze Family Fund Assistance in the amount of \$2,536 was provided to 6 of the 17 families who received assistance.
