


## IMPORTING CITRUS INTO SOUTH AUSTRALIA

### Regulated product Details are described in the SA Plant Quarantine Standard available at [www.pir.sa.gov.au/PQS](http://www.pir.sa.gov.au/PQS)

- Importer Registration (IR01) and Direct Inspections (DI) are subject to fees (IR01 is \$165 for first year and \$90/yr thereafter. DI is charged at \$143 per hour including travel)
- Citrus trees from Queensland are prohibited
- Citrus trees from within control areas for Citrus Canker (currently in WA and the NT) are prohibited
- Citrus trees from WA require certification to manage the following pests: green snail, pyriform scale and tomato potato psyllid
- Bare-rooted citrus trees (or those in a commercial potting mix) from NSW are regulated for entry into South Australia but need only provide declaration to meet conditions to prevent entry of Citrus Red Mite (if grown outside of affected counties), the Stem Pitting Strain of Tristeza Virus and Citrus Blight. Note - when only a Declaration is necessary, no Direct Inspection is required.

*Note that due to the pest Green Snail now being managed on a property basis in Victoria, bare-rooted citrus trees (or those in a commercial potting mix) from Victoria which are not grown on Green Snail affected properties (or properties that are linked to these) are no longer regulated for import into South Australia.*
