We are also trying to call you right now.

We have an issue with the VSD section of the Swine Chapter. There is a statement in the section stating that VSD should only be used as a last resort. If that is the case then VSD should be listed as Not Recommended instead of Permitted in Constrained Circumstances. In order to keep from downgrading the method we suggest the attached language be used instead. This will match the section to what is written in the Poultry chapter and keep VSD Plus in the Permitted in Constrained Circumstances if that is where you think it should be. We were also able to find a Book reference to support this language. The reference list will be cleaned up to match the rest of the document but we are in a crunch to finalize the main language before our main contact in Publications goes out of town.

Please let us know if these changes would be acceptable.
