Group Volunteering

- Team volunteering opportunities are available Tuesdays through Thursdays. We can also work with you for other volunteering days and hours.
- The ideal volunteer group size is five to twenty people.
- Most groups volunteer for between two to three hours.
- Teams help with special projects in the Free Store for Teachers and warehouse. Volunteers
 may be sorting and taking inventory of donations, stocking supplies, working in the warehouse
 the possibilities change daily!

Individual Volunteer Shifts

- Individual Volunteer shifts are available Tuesday through Thursday from 9am to Noon, or 1:30 to 4:30pm.
