Umlaut Kölsch

Our interpretation of the classic German style beer known as Kölsch. It's a blend of ale and lager characteristics that results in a smooth and refreshing beer. At its core – German pilsner malt, a touch of wheat to contribute to a creamy head, and very few hops make this a tasty summer beer. 5.4% ABV, 17 IBU

Weisse Grip Hefeweizen

This is a classic unfiltered Hefeweizen, a German-style wheat beer known for its cloudy appearance and easy drinkability! Loosely translated, "hefe" means yeast and "weizen" means wheat, which actually makes up more than half of the grain bill for this beer. Dosed with classic German hops and an authentic German beer yeast means you will notice wonderful fruity and floral flavors and aromas. This beer is sure to quench your thirst! 5.4% ABV, 19 IBU

Mainsail Cream Ale

Hints of malt and corn along with just a bit of residual sweetness make for a light and refreshing thirst quencher. This beer has a crisp, clean finish thanks to some extended cold conditioning and it's not too strong – just enough to keep you sailing full speed ahead. 6.5% ABV, 29 IBU

Ale-ien Blonde Ale

Possessing many of the ingredients found in a traditional lawnmower beer and the accompanying aromas of fresh malted grain, don't let this blonde ale fool you! Light, crisp, and refreshing thanks to a healthy amount of wheat and flaked maize, this beer has a little extra kick thanks to a large addition of agave syrup leaving just a hint of sweetness, balanced out by a couple of the "C" hops. 7.6% ABV, 42

Pinchy Red Ale

This ale owes its red color to a pinch of melanoidan malt. Other specialty grains contribute to a crisp and smooth session beer with hints of toasted bread and nuts. 4.5% ABV, 41 IBU

Tug Pale Ale

Ace Hole APA

Just 2-row malted barley, a few specialty grains and a touch of rye, this APA will give you a little zip on your tongue. This beer is charged with large doses of lupulin on the front and back end creating rich hop bitterness, flavor and aroma that's sure to please all of the hop heads out there. "Hop" on up and try one. ABV 7.2%, 84 IBU

MyShahRona NEIPA

Our most heavily hopped beer to date – 29# of hops (that's over 4# per barrel in brewery parlance). The trifecta of hops in this unfiltered hazy New England IPA hales from countries in both hemispheres and the synergistic effect is nothing short of amazing! The straw-colored haze emanates from a combination of high protein grains and biotransformation of a wicked huge amount of dry hops added early in the fermentation schedule. Described as hoppy, crisp and citrusy; for the owners it brings up images of sunshine and is reminiscent of that fruity drink we all know – T*NG. 5.1% ABV, 55 IBU

Big Twitch IPA

It's not a west coast IPA and it's not an east coast IPA, so call it somewhere in the middle – perhaps The Midwest IPA? This classic IPA is copper in color with just enough specialty malt to leave a touch of sweetness leaving hints of toasted caramel and toffee. Modest hopping using a blend of four different hops leaves you with notions of stone fruit and candied mango with just enough hop bite to yield a perfectly balanced tasty treat described as "Freakin' Delicious." 9.0% ABV, 75 IBU

Below the Belt IPA

This classic IPA was borne out of a desire to try some southern hemisphere hops. The result of a blend of Nelson Sauvin and Galaxy hops is an explosion of tropical fruit aromas and flavors backed up with a bold bitterness. Several hop additions, including multiple rounds of dry hopping, will surely appease the most devout hop heads out there! One might ask, "where's the white sand beach" to go with this? Oh, and the name has a secondary, non-geographical, meaning that will remain a secret. 6.7% ABV, 84 IBU

Combine that with a massive grain bill and incredibly efficient yeast and the result - a hop treat with a kick. Enjoy it while it lasts! 10.5% ABV, 121 IBU

Moonbat Black India Pale Lager

Don't let the dark color fool you! It's not too dark, not too stormy (and not too hoppy)! This black IPA packs a lot of flavor for a light, clean and crisp beer. Thanks to a deviation in normal brewing procedures, you get the classic hop nose and pleasant bitterness you would expect in an IPA thanks to a blend of American hops in the kettle and dry hopped; but wait there's more — you also get just a hint of roasted grain and all the dark color you might look for in a winter warmer. The smooth, refreshing finish is achieved thanks to an extended lagering time of six weeks. 6.4% ABV, 65 IBU

A rich concoction of European specialty malts and pale malt from The County creates a robust flavor powerhouse with a deep dark color. The roasted grains contribute to the chocolate, toffee, and caramel flavor and aromas this beer is known for while a touch of molasses leaves a pleasant residual sweetness that lingers to the last drop. Small dose of high alpha hops throughout the boils provide the hop backbone needed for the complex grain bill. The name speaks for itself- this beer packs (tasty) punch! 9.7% ABV, 79 IBU**
