

Health Screening Questionnaire

All DOE students, employees, and visitors must complete a health screening before entering DOE facilities. This health screening must be completed on each day of arrival. This health screening can also be completed online at: https://healthscreening.schools.nyc/. Upon entering the facility, if you have not completed the online health form you will be asked to provide responses to the questions below. As a reminder, all DOE employees must be vaccinated to enter our school buildings.

1.	throat, lo	experienced any symptoms of COVID-19, including a fever of 100.0 degrees F or greater, a new cough, sore assort sate or smell or shortness of breath that started in the past 10 days?
		No. Go to the next question. Yes, and I have received a negative result from a COVID-19 diagnostic test performed by a health care provider OR I am a student or school-based staff member who received two negative results from a takehome test taken at least 24 hours apart since the onset of symptoms AND have only mild symptoms (no runny nose; if cough, cough minimal and non-productive; fever-free for 24 hours without the use of medication). Go to the next question.
		Yes, and I am a school-based staff member returning on Day 6 of isolation with mild symptoms (no runny nose; if cough, cough minimal and non-productive; fever-free for 72 hours without the use of medication),
		wearing a higher-grade face covering such as a KN95 or N95. Go to the next question. Yes, and I am not in the categories above. No further screening is needed. The individual may not enter the building.
2.		st 10 days, have you gotten a positive result from a COVID-19 diagnostic test? Please note that 10 days is d from the day you were tested, not from the day when you got the test result. No. Go to the next question.
		Yes, and I am a school-based staff member returning on Day 6 of isolation with no symptoms or mild symptoms that are improving (no runny nose; if cough, cough minimal and non-productive; have been fever-free for 72 hours without the use of medication), wearing a higher-grade face covering such as a KN95 or N95. Go to the next question.
		Yes. No further screening is needed. The individual may not enter the building.
3.	In the pa	st 10 days, were you in close contact with someone who tested positive for COVID-19? No. The individual may enter the building.
		Yes, I was exposed at school, and am taking COVID-19 diagnostic test(s) as directed by my school and have NOT received a positive result on those tests. If I test positive, I will begin isolation. The individual may enter the building.
		Yes, I was exposed at school but I have not received a home test kit. Please contact your school to ensure you receive a home test kit today. The individual may enter the building.
		Yes, and I am not fully vaccinated returning from quarantine from an exposure outside of school on Day 8 with proof of a negative diagnostic COVID-19 test performed on Day 5 or later. The individual may enter the building.
		Yes, I was exposed outside of school , but I am considered fully vaccinated. The individual may enter the building.
		Yes, and I was exposed outside of schoo l and I am not fully vaccinated. The individual may not enter the building.

As a reminder, in accordance with New York State Department of Health requirements, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommendations, and DOE policies, all individuals in a DOE school building and all DOE staff and contractors in DOE offices MUST wear a face covering at all times, unless eating or drinking or unless they have a medical exemption.

This Health Screening is not intended to be a substitute for professional medical advice, diagnosis, or treatment. Always seek the advice of a qualified health provider with any questions you may have regarding a medical condition. Health screening results will be reviewed for the sole purpose of gaining access to facilities and confidentiality will be maintained.
