With the second weekend of football soon upon us, and for some that incurred the wet weather approaching their first game, its timely to remind all – Team Officials and Match Officials – of the need to ensure the Dribl online *Match Sheets* are attended to correctly. This is especially important in the Premiership Divisions (U13+).

In the SSF ages (U8-U12) it is still necessary to properly complete the Match Sheet. It is an official record of those present and participating in the fixture. Additionally, the result is used as part of the mid-year Review process consideration for division realignments.

Across all competitions the information utilised by the Association in varying areas is only as good as that entered by the individuals involved in the game. Again, this is particularly important for the Premiership Divisions where online automatic result and table updates can only be attended to when the game data has been correctly entered.

It is important those utilising the Dribl App have the most up to date version.

To ensure matches can commence on time and any issues raised can be dealt with in a timely manner, it is appreciated that teams are **Submitted** and **Confirmed** ideally 30 minutes prior of the scheduled kick-off time.
