Corporal Punishment Permission Form

Corporal Punishment

In determining whether to use corporal punishment, the following considerations should be taken into account: the seriousness of the offense, the attitude and past behavior of the student, the age and strength of the student, and the availability of equally effective nonphysical means of discipline. Therefore, corporal punishment is a last resort in disciplining your student and not the first response.

Corporal punishment may not be administered for academic deficiency or conduct not related to the school.

Corporal punishment must be approved by the school administrator. Corporal punishment may be administered by the school administrator, the Pastor of MAG Church who resides on the board for MAG Christian Academy, or another designated teacher on staff. One adult employee of the school shall be present to witness the spanking.

There must be a time of explanation to the student as well as a time of praying. The administrator or another designated employee will pray with your student before and after administering corporal punishment.

Corporal punishment will be administered by spanking the buttocks, no more than three (3) times, of a student with a flat-surfaced paddle that will cause no more than temporary pain and not inflict permanent damage to the body. No other form of corporal punishment is authorized.

Dress Code

The dress code established at MAG Christian Academy provides benefits to the educational experience for students, teachers, and families, by allowing teachers and administrators to focus on school community and academics, rather than on monitoring the appropriateness of various clothing choices. MAG Christian Academy is committed to facilitate a community in which students' individual preferences are expressed, in the context of modesty and respect for others. Dress code includes:

- Navy and/or orange polo shirts with no logo
- Khaki or navy-blue pants, skirts, uniform shorts, or uniform dresses. Shorts, skirts, and uniform dresses must be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee. (No athletic material except during PE)
- Denim pants, shorts, or skirts are allowed only on Thursdays with their MAGCA t-shirts
- No yoga pants or leggings (leggings can be worn under a skirt)
- No sweatpants or athletic pants, or athletic shorts (except during PE for 5th – 11th grade)
- All pants/shorts/skirts/dresses must be in good repair with no holes or tears
- Length of shorts/skirts/dresses must be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee
- No hats or hoods worn during school hours
- Hooded sweatshirts may be worn that are school colors navy or orange or their MAG CA hoodie
- Zipped sweatshirts may be worn but kept unzipped during the school day to show the student is in proper uniform attire
- Hair must be neat and trimmed with natural hair color and no extreme styles
- Full-coverage bathing suits must be worn on school trips that provide opportunities for swimming
- Boys must wear a t-shirt with swim shorts. Girls must wear a cover-up over their bathing suit
- Unusual or outlandish styles in clothing or hair that detracts from the educational environment will be addressed by administration
- During casual dress days, students will refrain from wearing clothing promoting secular music bands, tobacco logos, alcohol logos, inappropriate speech, and fantasy characters (i.e., anime, etc....)
