This year-long program consists of two in-person intensives in the Dallas metro area with a supervised practicum in between, equipping experienced spiritual directors to offer contemplative, compassionate, evocative supervision! Program Consists of:

- Opening intensive: August 1-4, 2024
- Closing intensive: **August 7-10, 2025**Both intensives take place at Retreat House in Richardson, TX. They begin on Thursday after supper and end on Sunday after lunch.
- Two Synchronous Zoom Gatherings:
 - o Saturday November 16th, 2024 11am-3pm CT
 - Saturday June 7th, 2025 11am-3pm CT
- **Supervision Practicum:** Eight months of individual supervision/mentoring between intensives as you establish or grow your supervision ministry. Offered by Vanessa Caruso and Tara Owens
- **Asynchronous Community Space** for gathering with colleagues throughout the training.

Prerequisites:

- 3-5 years of experience offering spiritual direction
- Reference from your spiritual director
- Receiving regular supervision for at least one year prior to applying for this training.
- Reference from your supervisor (or a facilitator or member of your supervision group)

Application Fee: \$90 (nonrefundable) **Maximum Enrollment:** 12 participants
