- Receiving regular supervision for at least one year prior to applying for this training.
- Reference from your supervisor (or a facilitator or member of your supervision group)
- Registration for our Advanced Certificate in Supervision

Application Fee: \$90 (nonrefundable)

Maximum Enrollment: 8 participants (with sufficient interest, we will offer two sections of this training).

Program Cost: \$650

- Art of Supervision 2: January 15 April 2, 2025 (with synchronous and asynchronous engagement)

 - Identifying and Navigating Challenging Relational Dynamics
 - Perceiving God with the Spiritual Senses
 - Collaboration on several supervision case presentations and videos featuring experienced directors
 - Concretizing Capstone Project
 - 2-hour Zoom Gathering Every Third Wednesday starting January 15, 2024 (exact time of gatherings will be determined to fit the locations of our participants).
- **Time allocation**: plan for 6-8 hours each week per course, apart from the Zoom Gatherings
