

# Service Memo

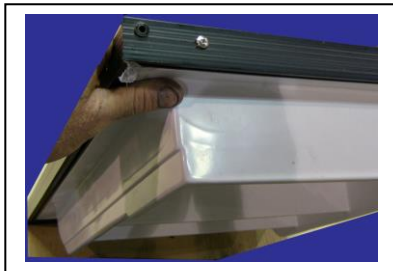
**To:** Service Personnel

**Re:** Bulging door liner from buildup of pressure inside the door liner

---

***Remove door and turn upside down, on carpet or soft non scratching material***

On the opposite side of the shelf from the highest part of the bulging door liner put a small hole in the under the bulge through the bottom of the liner.



***Do not go through the top of the liner***

With your scribe poke the hole through the bottom liner and the foam (inside the liner) until you get to the top liner and **STOP**. This will allow the pressure to vent.

With the use of the shelf and the weight of the product on it the shelf, it will return to normal over time.

***If you go through the top shelf liner by accident use a small amount of plastic cement (model) this will seal it***



This is caused in very hot environments as the foam can give off a little pressure over time .
