If we were shrewd in an evil way, we may be admired by other evil people for our cleverness. But we cannot win in the long run. **We cannot divide ourselves between God and worldly gain.** Conniving, unjust, irresponsible, underhanded, thieving, and untrustworthy - all words that could apply to the steward in this weekend's Gospel. Yet in the parable, the master gives him credit for his enterprising attitude, because even as he was losing his job, he was managing to look out for himself. Jesus does not recommend this sort of behavior, but he does point out what a believer must contend with in this world. **Remaining just and true in modern society is not always easy, but it is the calling we have received,** and we must strive to do it with all our hearts.
