
Public art can tell a story.

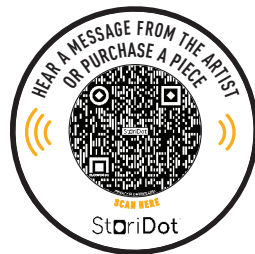
