

## ARP Plan Remediation and Instructional Support to Fight Learning Loss Due to COVID-19

## 1. Use of Funds

- a. Student Data Aggregation Software
  - Northwest Classical Academy (NCA) is allocating a portion of their ARP funds (11.65%) to purchase student data aggregation software to monitor progress and evaluate their strategies and effectiveness in fighting learning loss due to COVID-19.
  - ii. Attendance, assessment, academic, behavior, and economic status data are needed to create a full comprehensive student profile to accurately assess learning loss, growth, and the effectiveness of NCA's strategy to fight learning loss. NCA will use a student data aggregation software called Prolifitic to synthesize data as effectively and accurately as possible to create the required comprehensive reports. With Proliftic, NCA can produce school, grade, class, and student level reports that combine all attendance, assessment, academic, behavior, and economic status data to provide clear guidance on our efforts to reverse learning loss. NCA will also use Proliftic to manage interventions and monitor at-risk students.
- b. Supplemental Instructional Support with Teaching Assistants
  - NCA is allocating the remaining funds (83.35%) for the salaries of teaching assistants to provide individual and small group support to students to fight the effects of learning loss due to COVID-19.

## 2. Strategy

a. NCA will provide supplemental support to students individually and in small groups with teaching assistants in an effort to reverse learning loss. NCA will monitor progress and evaluate the effectiveness of its strategy through the use of a student data aggregation software called Proliftic. The academic leadership team will meet on a monthly basis to review the data and refine NCA's strategy as and if needed.
