2003	Garfield-Rifle	CO	2003T94(County)	People Of The State Of Colorado Vs. Roberts, Lauren Opal *** Boebert, under her maiden name, was charged with Careless Driving-cause Death/injury on 1/11/2003 by the Colorado State Patrol. This charge was amended and she pleaded to a lesser charge of Speeding Too Fast for Conditions, which is an infraction. She paid a \$66 fine and would have just turned 16.
2004	Garfield-- Rifle	CO	2004T104(County)	People Of The State Of Colorado Vs. Roberts, Lauren Opal ** Boebert, under her maiden name Roberts, was charged by the Garfield County Sheriff on 1/21/04 for speeding 10-19 over the limit (noting she was doing 45 in a 35 mph zone), and failure to display proof of insurance. She pleaded guilty to a lesser charge of speeding 5-9 over the limit on 3/31/04. She paid a \$69 fine.
2010	Garfield - Rifle	CO	2010M508(County)	People Of The State Of Colorado Vs. Boebert, Lauren Opal ** Boebert was charged by the Garfield County Sheriff with two Dog At Large violations and a Dog Licensing Violation on 9/21/10. Two of the charges were dismissed and Boebert pleaded guilty to one Dog at Large charge on 10/20/10 and paid a \$111 fine. The case was closed on 10/20/10.
2010	Garfield	CO	2010CV977(District)	Gmac Mortgage Llc Vs. Boebert, Jayson Et Al ** Jayson and Lauren Boebert were both defendants in a suit from GMAC Mortgage LLC filed on 7/16/10. A rule 120 hearing was held on 8/9/10, which is usually the initiation of a foreclosure. The case was closed on 8/9/10. County records indicate that GMAC and the Boeberts were listed on a Notice Election & Demand Sale with the Garfield Public Trustee on 5/13/10, which often is associated with a debt default or foreclosure.
2011	Garfield - Rifle	CO	2011T935(County)	People Of The State Of Colorado Vs. Boebert, Lauren O *** Boebert was charged by Colorado State Patrol on 10/20/11 with multiple seatbelt violations. Boebert was initially charged with failing to wear her seatbelt as the driver, two counts of not using a child restraint, and failing to display proof of insurance. Boebert pleaded guilty to one of the counts of failing to use a child restraint, and the other charges were dismissed. Boebert paid an \$83.50 fine. The case was closed on 12/14/11.
2012	Garfield - Rifle	CO	2012C1205(County)	Capital One Bank Usa Na Vs. Boebert, Lauren O *** Capital One Bank entered a summons and complaint against Boebert on 10/18/12 over a debt of \$1,368.98, plus \$147.07 of court costs. Boebert failed to appear at a hearing on 11/20/12 and a motion for default was entered on 12/3/12 and a default judgment was entered on 12/12/12. A writ of continuing garnishment of Boebert's earnings was issued both on 8/15/16 and 7/11/17. The judgment was listed as satisfied on 11/14/17 and the case was listed as closed on 12/12/12.
2015	Mesa	CO	C0392015M 001472	Boebert was arrested on 12/1/15 by the Mesa County Sheriff office for a failure to appear (FTA), dating from an offense on 12/20/15. The original charge of disorderly conduct--offensive gesture was a petty offense from 6/20/15 dismissed by the DA
2015	Mesa	CO	2015M1472(County)	People Of The State Of Colorado Vs. Boebert, Lauren ** Boebert was charged with Disorderly Conduct-Offensive Gesture, a petty offense. She was issued a summons by ticket on 6/20/15, and the charge was dismissed by the DA on 1/22/16. On 8/28/15 a brief failure to appear was entered and quickly canceled on the same day. On 11/20/15, Boebert again failed to appear and a warrant was issued for her arrest. The warrant was canceled on 12/2/15 after Boebert posted a \$50 bond. The case was dismissed on 1/22/16.
2015	Larimer	CO	2015R2398(County)	People Of The State Of Colorado Vs. Boebert, Lauren O ** Boebert was charged by Colorado State Patrol - Loveland with expired license plates on 7/14/15. She was found guilty on 9/25/15 and ordered to pay a \$185 fine after failing to appear in court for the 9/25/15 hearing.
2016	Garfield - Rifle	CO	2016T721(County)	People Of The State Of Colorado Vs. Bobert, Lauren O ** Boebert was charged with Careless Driving by Colorado State Patrol on 7/22/16. The charge was dismissed and she pleaded guilty to a lesser charge of operating an unsafe or defective vehicle on 3/13/17. Boebert was ordered to pay a \$123.50 fine. Boebert failed to appear for a hearing on 10/5/16 and a warrant was issued for her arrest. The warrant was canceled on 2/13/17 after she paid a \$100 bond. The case was closed on 3/13/17.
2017	Garfield*	CO	C0642016T 000721	Boebert was arrested by Colorado State Patrol (reporting out of the Craig Communications office, so it is not clear were the arrest occurred) on 2/13/17 for a failure to appear (FTA) in Garfield County. The original charge related to a careless driving offense from 7/22/16. Boebert's arrest number was 51097.

2017	Garfield - Rifle	CO	2017R251(County)	People Of The State Of Colorado Vs. Boebert, Lauren D ** Boebert was charged by Colorado State Patrol on 4/6/17 for not wearing a seat belt and twice for not using a child restraint. The two child restraint charges were dismissed and Boebert pleaded guilty to Seat Belt Not Used on 6/26/17 and the case was closed after Boebert paid a \$61.50 fine.
2018	Garfield - Rifle	CO	2018C80(County)	Boebert, Lauren Opal Vs. Martinez, Jenifer ** Boebert requested and was granted a Temporary Restraining Order against Jenifer Martinez (DOB 1/1/73) on 7/12/18. A hearing was held for a permanent order on 7/18/18, although the case summary does not indicate the outcome. The temporary restraining order was vacated on 11/6/18, suggesting it was continued in the summer. A note in the case summary says a party failed to appear for the 11/6 hearing, although it does not say who. Presumably Boebert, the plaintiff, did not appear. The complaint was dismissed without prejudice and closed on 11/6/18.
2018	Garfield - Rifle	CO	2018C133(County)	Boebert, Lauren Opal Vs. Martinez, Jennifer ** Boebert requested another temporary protection order against Jennifer Martinez (DOB 1/1/73) on 12/21/18. A hearing was held on 1/2/19 and a permanent protection order was granted, suggesting a judge found merit in the complaint. The case was closed on 1/2/19.
2019	Clear Creek	CO	2019R611(County)	People Of The State Of Colorado Vs. Boebert, Lauren Opal *** Boebert was charged by the Clear Creek Sheriff Dept. on 11/11/19 for speeding 5-9mph over the limit and following too closely. The speeding charge was dismissed and Boebert pleaded guilty to the following charge and paid an \$87.50 fine. The case was closed on 2/26/20.
2020	Garfield	CO	2020CV30073(District	Garfield County Public Health Vs. Shooters Grill Llc Et Al ** Shooters Grill and owner Lauren Boebert were sued in Garfield District Court by the Garfield County Health Department on 5/13/2020. A hearing was held on 5/15/20 and a preliminary injunction was issued on 5/18/20 by Judge Anne Kirkpatrick Norrdin. On 5/26/20, the status was vacated and the case was closed.
2020	Garfield	CO	2020C14(County)	Boebert, Lauren Vs. Camp, Joseph A *** Boebert sought a temporary restraining order against Joey Camp (DOB 5/28/84) on 2/6/20. Camp is a self-described "candidate for everything" who was filed to run in CD3 and is currently running a gadfly candidate for president. Camp also says he is the editor of "Feeling Cute Newz" and has been seen live streaming BLM protests and posting pictures of protesters. On his website, Camp claims he was suing Boebert under anti-SLAPP laws for trying to silence him. It is unclear why the two were fighting or what the resolution was. At the temporary restraining order hearing on 3/11/20, a note in the summary says the party failed to appear, although it does not say who. Presumably Boebert, as the plaintiff, did not appear. The temporary protection order was vacated on 3/11/20 and the case was closed.
2020	Garfield - Rifle	CO	2020C51(County)	Boebert, Lauren Vs. Camp, Joseph A ** Boebert sought what appears to be a second temporary restraining order against Joey Camp on 3/31/20. For two permanent restraining order hearings, one on 4/14/20 and 4/28/20, a party is listed as failing to appear, although it does not say who. Possibly Camp, as the defendant, failed to appear at the first hearing, and Boebert at the second. The restraining order was vacated on 4/28/20 and the case was dismissed without prejudice.
2020	Garfield - Rifle	CO	2020C51(County)	Boebert, Lauren Vs. Camp, Joseph A ** Boebert sought what appears to be a second temporary restraining order against Joey Camp on 3/31/20. For two permanent restraining order hearings, one on 4/14/20 and 4/28/20, a party is listed as failing to appear, although it does not say who. Possibly Camp, as the defendant, failed to appear at the first hearing, and Boebert at the second. The restraining order was vacated on 4/28/20 and the case was dismissed without prejudice.
2020	Eagle	CO	2020R291(County)	People Of The State Of Colorado Vs. Boebert, Lauren D *** Boebert was charged with speeding 10-19 mph over the limit by Colorado State Patrol - Glenwood Springs on 1/29/20. Another charge of speeding 20-24 over the limit amended, and Boebert pleaded guilty to the lesser charge and paid a \$193.50 fine. The case was closed on 5/8/20.
