Workforce Solutions of Central Texas' Child Care Quality Improvement Initiatives, and the United Way of Central Texas partnered with Children at Risk of Texas to establish the Central Texas Shared Services Alliance. This child care quality improvement initiative focuses on Bell, Coryell, Lampasas, Hamilton, Milam, Mills and San Saba counties. The initiative provides assistance to child care providers in developing sound early care and education business practices, while offering high quality services to children, families and child care staff.

Together, Central Texas early child care providers can become stronger, more financially sound, efficient, sustainable and better able to deliver high-quality child care services that leads to school-ready students who can excel and become valuable members of our future workforce.

SUMMARY OF APPROACH

The Central Texas Shared Services Alliance is made up of six Early Learning Child Care Centers. Of the six centers participating there are 84 teachers, 14 administrators, and 631 children being served. These six Early Learning Child Care Centers have agreed to be a part of the pilot group. After time, the alliance will be extended to other Early Learning Child Care Centers within the community. The mission is to alleviate administration staff of back office duties so that they can provide more time to the staff, family, and children to ensure school readiness.
