POPULATION SERVED

Describe demographics of children served by the Alliance; numbers of children served: As of 2022, All Our Kin directly serves over 1100 family child care educators, who in turn educate and care for over 6,750 children from the most overburdened, under-resourced families in Connecticut and New York City. Through Training and Technical Assistance, All Our Kin has reached 21 states and Washington D.C. with our model. Partners work with family child care educators or systems and include community-based organizations, unions, child care resource and referral agencies, educator groups, and federal, state, and local government.

SUMMARY OF APPROACH

All Our Kin is a national nonprofit organization that trains, supports, and sustains family child care providers. Our mission to transform the nation's child care system results in a triple win: child care providers succeed as business owners; working parents find stable, high-quality care for their children; and children gain an educational foundation that lays the groundwork for achievement.

- As a multi-site non-profit, AOK provides some shared services to the family child care
 networks including, but not limited to, a zero interest loan fund, professional development
 sessions offered virtually, and a website for educators in the process of accreditation.
- In New Haven, the AOK network hosts an Early Head Start program through which educators have access to nurse and mental health consultants, family services, child enrollment, and more.
- Through Training and Technical Assistance, AOK builds the capacity of organizations across
 the country. Supports are provided to leaders working with family child care educators
 across the areas of business development, policy advising, educational coaching, licensing
 support, and network development.
