POPULATION SERVED

Baltimore City has 53,305 children under 4 years of age. The population is 30.5% white and 62.4% Black; and has 379 FCC and 156 CC Centers.

Prince George's County has 80,997 children under four years of age. The population is 12.3% white, 64.4% Black, 19.5% LatinX, and 4.4% Asian; and has 724 FCC and 249 CC Centers.

Montgomery County has 80,41 under 4 years of age. The population is 42.9% white, 20.1% LatinX, 20.1% Black and 15.6% Asian; and has 724 FCC and 249 CC Centers.

SUMMARY OF APPROACH

MFN is working in partnership with 3 local CCRCs to recruit a cohort of 60 family child care providers to participate in a shared services pilot project. We will launch a second cohort of center-based providers in fall 2022. The project has four components: professional community building, implementation of a CCMS to promote automation and efficiency, business training and small group coaching, and shared services (TBD by the cohort).
