We currently have 350 members across the state. We charge a membership fee for centers of \$300 per year, with a renewal fee of \$250 and home providers of \$150, with \$100 for renewal.We have partnered with Early Learning Ventures to bring their CORE program to our providers. We are a small non-profit, based in the Upstate of South Carolina, with 4 employees that work together to create change for the ECE cmmunity in SC.
