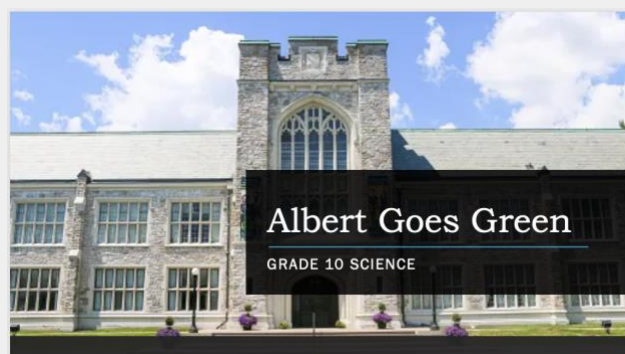




Albert College Goes Green

Grade 10 Science Class Initiative

- *94.4% people agree that Albert College should be a plastic bottle free school.*

Plastic is not biodegradable, but it appears in every part of our lives. It may be possible to reduce plastic waste at the source by reducing the amount of plastic being provided.

The students researched, educated, and conducted surveys – here are some of the results and comments...

- *I want to eliminate plastic water bottles because in the end it is our generation that will be dealing with the problem of an unhealthy environment, and I want to do my part to help in making Albert College an environmentally friendly environment.*

- ***170 single use water bottles were consumed per day – which is a significant cost to AC.***

- *We should be passionate about this cause because we are using, and incredible amount of single use water bottles every day. This has a big impact on the environment, so we have decided to eliminate the single use water bottles and replace them with Albert Personalized Water Bottles.*

The Grade 10 science class of 2021 was tasked with picking an environmental initiative that could significantly impact Albert College. The class decided that the usage and waste of single use water bottles would make the biggest impact. Since the start of COVID-19 pandemic, the school has provided students with single use water bottles. This has resulted in the average student using three or more water bottles every day. Many of these bottles are not being recycled which means that they are ending up in landfills and dumps.

- ensure that the bottle is hand-washed each night and in their backpack for the next day.

Bottles are stainless steel but are NOT dishwasher safe as the label will come off.
