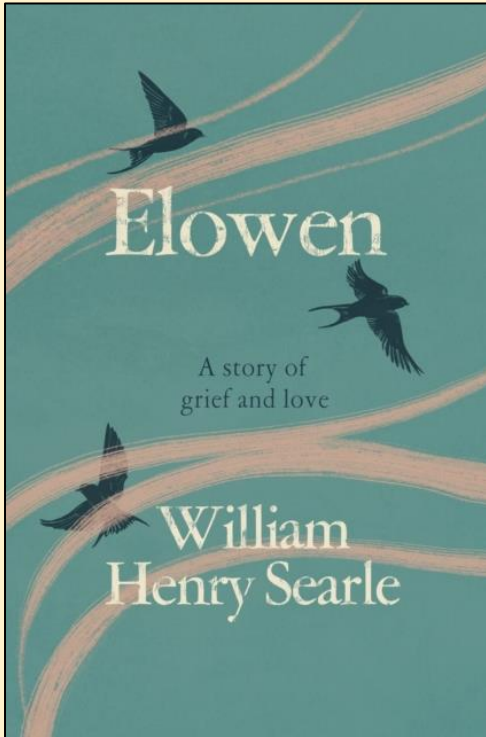


# Wild Book Talk
