The Project Coordinator will be responsible for managing promotions, advertisement, content development and a social media campaign for Craft Year 2015, a nation-wide, year-long, collaborative festival of events featuring fine craft in Canada. Guided by supervisors and a project committee, they will develop and launch the Craft Year 2015 website with vibrant content, as well as a widespread social media campaign, and assist in the production of and preparation for a national conference.

Qualifications:

- A university degree or college diploma in craft, art, design, arts administration or other related field
- Must have graduated in the past 24 months
- Fluency in English, with intermediate skills in written and spoken French (fluency is a definite asset)
- Intermediate level competence with a computer (including Microsoft word, Excel and various social media platforms), familiarity with web content management systems is an asset
- A high level of skill in reading, writing and editing
- Experience working as a craft artist, or with craft artists in a professional capacity
- Applicants must be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or have refugee status in Canada, must be legally entitled to work in Canada, and must be between the ages of 16 and 30.
