Bell Projects presents – *ghetto kids have dreams too* – a solo exhibition featuring new work by **Miguel Aguilar**. This exhibition opens Friday, July 7 and runs through July 30, 2023. Please join us for an opening reception on July 7th from 6pm until 10pm.

Miguel Aguilar (b. 1993) was born and raised in Southern California. Growing up in a rough neighborhood made him seek an alternative outlet than the lifestyle that was glorified and normalized. He always admired the tagging in the streets, and although it was gang affiliated, it was his first exposure to painting on walls. In addition to seeing the graffiti on buildings throughout his neighborhood, the beaches that he frequented in California and Mexico always had an array of artwork on their boardwalks. The styles ranged from the best graffiti styles you've ever seen, to beginner murals.

These influences and introductions to art at a young age gave him the courage to start his own path as an artist. Aguilar attended the Rocky Mountain College of Art and Design from 2015-2017 for a degree in illustration. It was here that he discovered his love of oil paint, blending the historicism of classical painters with his upbringing in Santa Ana to develop a unique style all his own. In the exhibition *ghetto kids have dreams too*, you will see the range of Aguilar's work, from portraits to still lives, each painting employ a thick application of paint, expressive mark-making, and rich storytelling.

Miguel Aguilar is a Mexican American artist who represents West Coast Latin culture in his love for figurative painting.
