Waterdog park is surrounded on all sides by residential deve and the existing wildlife has adapted to the presence of people in this area. We are fortunate to already have a 23,000 acre w preserve nearby on the other side of 280 (the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission Peninsula Watershed). Keeping the W Open Space as the recreational park it is today is one of the highlights that leads my family to desire to stay in this area. One of the activities that I personally enjoy in Waterdog is being able to ride my mountain bike in a safe and natural environm is easily accessible from my home.
