

HOW TO RESIZE YOUR PHOTOS

If you are using **Photoshop** example below:

Go to, **File, Export, Export As...**

A new window will open. On the right side under **File Settings - Format: JPG, Quality 100%**

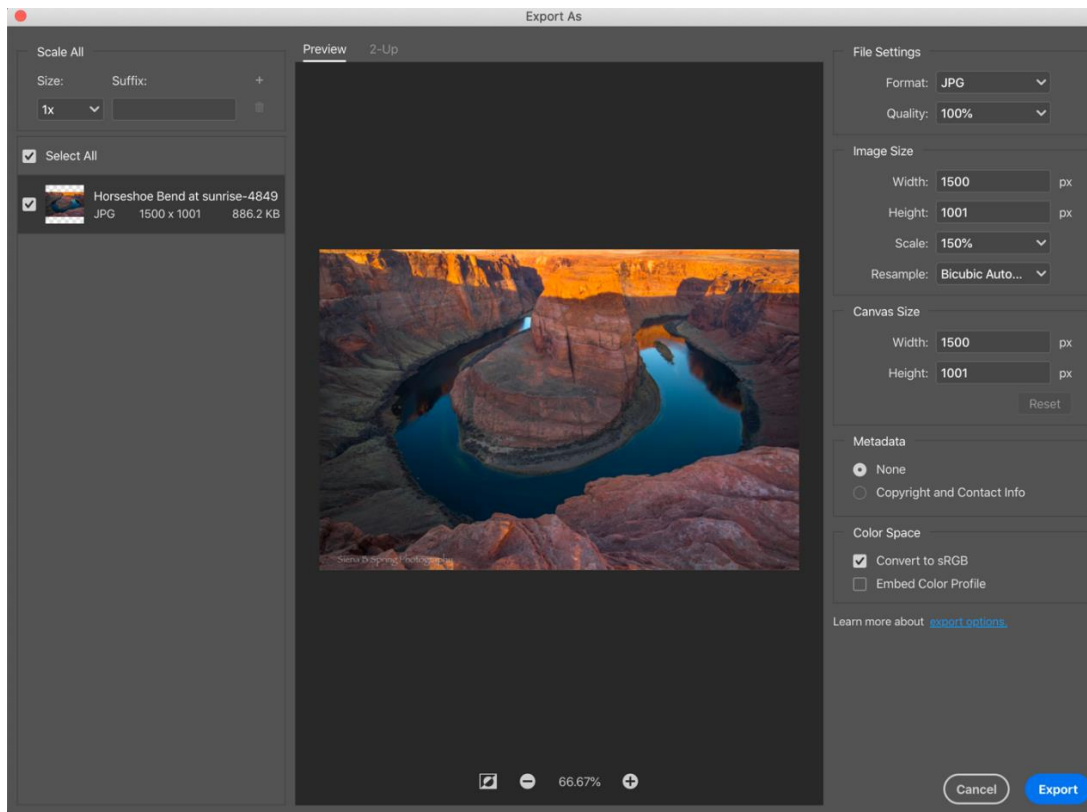
Image Size –

Adjust the **WIDTH** to between **1200- 1500 px**. (Height does not matter)

At the bottom of the window you will see - Color Space- check the box **Convert to sRGB**

Export your image to a file on your computer. **Be sure you Rename** your photo to the description above.

If you are using **Lightroom**: Example below

Go to File – Export

A new window will open.

Export Location - Export To: Choose where you want your photo to go.

Then use the dropdown arrow next to **Existing Files**: Choose a new name for the exported files.

File Naming – Check the box Rename To: Choose Custom Name

Custom Text: G_E_sunset_SusanW

Example: G_E_sunset_SusanW.jpg

File Setting

Image Format: JPEG

Color Space sRGB - **Do not** check the box Limit File Size To:

Image Sizing

Check the box - Resize to Fit: **Width & Height**. Make image size between 1200- 1500 pixels **ON THE WIDTH (Height does not matter.)**

Resolution set to 72dpi. (pixels per inch)

Click on Export
