

Supply List

It is recommended that class participants have these supplies on hand for use throughout the course. **Bold** items are links to supplies online.

GENERAL SUPPLIES

Acrylic Paints

Any acrylic paint will work, including small bottles of craft paint by brands like Apple Barrel and Folk Art. Tubes of acrylic by Grumbacher, Daler-Rowney, and others are especially good for gel plate printing. Textile paints are also fine. No dyes and no tempera or other washable paint.

Assorted Papers

Plain printer paper, handmade papers, specialty papers, old book pages or sheet music. Junk mail. Be adventurous.

Deli Paper: Plain white or natural, not printed.

Fabrics

Any fabric – cotton, silk, synthetic

Gel plate

There are several brands of these, and some are less expensive than others. I have three sizes. If purchasing, consider buying one that is at least 8" x 10". **My recommendation.**

4" Brayer – **My recommendation.**

Paint brush assortment including 1" foam brush

Fusible web, preferably Misty Fuse

Scissors for paper and fabric

Cutting mat

OPTIONAL: Inktense blocks or pencils – **My recommendation.**

ADDITIONAL SUPPLIES BY WEEK

Week One

- ▶ **Box of soap erasers**
- ▶ #11 exacto knife
- ▶ 1" foam brush
- ▶ Flat plate or palette
- ▶ Glue gun
- ▶ **Fast 'n Final Spackle**
- ▶ Stencils
- ▶ Bath tub Caulk
- ▶ Masking Tape
- ▶ Several pieces of heavy cardboard, like the back of a pad of drawing paper
- ▶ Optional: Flannel backed vinyl or tablecloth

Week Two

- ▶ Gel plate
- ▶ Stamps created from Week 1
- ▶ Assorted appropriated textures:
 - ▶ plastic bags or wrap, netting/cheesecloth, window screen, tomato netting
 - ▶ Corrugated cardboard
 - ▶ Spray bottle

 - ▶ Cottage cheese container or other glass or plastic container

Week Four

- ▶ Acrylic paint markers
- ▶ Brown paper/old maps etc
- ▶ Hair conditioner
