



Trend #4 / Embracing the curves


More couples will be doing it their own way when it comes to the table layout for their wedding meal. There will be a move away from the traditional top table format, as well as banquet or round tables

Trend #5 / Food-focused

Food will be a huge focus for couples in 2024, for both eating (naturally) and for styling their weddings tables.

On the eating side, there is a desire for simple, tasty and authentic Italian cuisine. Nothing fancy or outside of the box. Quality food done right.

Table styling will heavily incorporate food items, in a sporadic, sprawling and unique way. Perfection is out and a modern take on rustic is in.

"Food will become the main decorative element in table design. Where we have previously seen food used as a complement to floral decoration, now it will have a starring role. Food will be fashioned into actual sculptures. Even the most unexpected foods will become the center of these still life, artistic tables."

Additionally, sculptural fruit compositions are being integrated with florals to evoke a contemporary feel while celebrating the essence of Italian aesthetics."

Trend #7 / Retro revival





Trend #9 / Food fashion

"More and more couples are looking for simple and delicious 'home-cooked' food and quality products.

Pizza nights will continue to be a popular choice for the welcome dinner but with edible and vegetable decoration, for example piling up beautiful varieties of tomatoes, artichokes, and peppers as a centerpiece.

In 2021 I created a giant pavlova of 1.20m for an adorable Australian couple who loved my pavlova but wanted it imposing and placed on a round table. Inspired by the aesthetics of the Italian millefoglie, I created this dessert and it was a huge success; we have served many more pavlova this year!

In 2024 we will see this trend for XXL desserts rise. Giant pavlova, giant strawberry pie, giant chocolate opera, or classic desserts in abundance. I have a wedding coming up for a very creative client who works in catering in NYC, and we will create a cascade of baba au rhum, whipped cream arranged in a large old serving dish."

Trend #9 / Food fashion

"For the main event dishes to share are on trend for the dinner; meat cooked for a long time, stuffed vegetables from the south, fresh whole fish, risotto, and fettuccine with truffle. Couples crave the simplicity of beautiful produce, well cooked with a small amount of other ingredients.

For late-night snacks, we will see a rise in proper comfort food: grilled cheese with comté & truffle, grazing tables, chocolate fondant, etc. any street food but with local & quality ingredients."






Trend #11 / Surprise moments

Unique experiences are the new luxury. Gifting life-long memories, delighting your guests, and creating a whole damn moment is the vibe for 2024.




Trend #11 / Surprise moments

Trend #12 / Curated reality


Weddings in 2024 will be all about embracing your own reality, crafting celebrations that are 100% you and capturing all the realness that comes with it.




Trend #13 / Statement jewellery

Trend #14 / Bridal fashion


