With accountability at our core, we've ensured that your contributions have been utilized wisely, aligning with our shared mission to care for the soul of the city.



Since 1989, we have cared for the soul of the city by encouraging giving.


We continue to convene nonprofits in addressing gospel driven goals, in witness, by either word or deed.

We are also engaged with philanthropy for the many pressing issues facing our province, including mental health, food insecurity and education.

The 56th BC Leadership Prayer Breakfast

In June, the annual **British Columbia Leadership Prayer Breakfast and Dinner** were held in person at the Hyatt Regency in Vancouver with more than 1000 in attendance.

The weekend is a significant annual event in the life of the city and a unique occasion for people of faith to come together in an intimate setting to share conversation and offer support and prayer for our leaders and each other.

This year's invited speakers were the Canadian leader, **Chief Phil Fontaine, and his wife, Professor Kathleen Mahoney.** **Chief Fontaine** has served an unprecedented nine years as National Chief of the Canadian Assembly of First Nations and he is best known for his central role in raising public awareness of the Canadian Indian residential school system and pushing to secure Federal and Papal apologies.

His life was fashioned by his faith and experiences growing up in the church. He spoke to us about the power of forgiveness and how he took the unusual initiative, as the wounded party, to open a process of reconciliation.

During these opportunities, engaging conversations happen, ideas are shared and these men and women make our youth feel that they matter, as a result, our students develop greater confidence and selfesteem.

He also has raised hundreds of thousands of dollars for bursaries for our high school grads to attend their first two years of college.

I value and respect Tom's work. He is a man of deep faith, and I admire his ability to develop and nurture relationships both personal and professional. He cares deeply for others and his unconditional love and encouragement have pulled many through some very difficult circumstances.

Nonprofits are positioned for innovation.

As nonprofits and charities everywhere continue to grapple with the ever-evolving challenges of our time, we are affirmed in our belief that City in Focus will continue to act as an incubator for positive change in the city.

Historically, our model of community transformation was built on two pillars. Firstly, discern where God is already at work and join Him there.

The second, lead philanthropists and donors to build meaningful partnerships with organizations and each other, thereby becoming catalysts for new opportunities for ministry and unity. To guide us moving forward, we have developed a model for innovation outlined by the initials AEIOU:

Accelerate - add fuel. Amplify what's already working.

Educate - and inform with media training, support and consultation to nonprofits. Level the playing field so their voices can be raised up.

Invest - in one another and continue to work together in practical ways.

Originate - original content that connects. We are currently developing a limited episode podcast on *The Future of Philanthropy*.


The vision of City in Focus is to captivate and mobilize the business community to assist in the renewing of the soul of the city.

Together, we are making a difference in the lives of those we serve and we look forward to continuing our journey of positive transformation.


