Not only will this super little pad look stylish, it's also designed to provide a perfect nesting environment for birds in New Zealand. Made in New Zealand from quality marine ply, its walls are thick enough to provide warmth and shelter. The lucky birds who call it home will be very thankful.

## **Right spot:**

Your Kohab Birdhouse should be positioned in a sheltered spot, away from bright sunlight and in, or near, some vegetation so they feel safe. And make sure it's not somewhere a cat or possum can reach.

## **Looking after your birdhouse:**

As with all outside wood products you can extend your birdhouses lifespan with a little bit of love. We recommend sealing it with raw Linseed Oil. This is safe for wildlife and easily found in large DIY stores.

## **Look after generation after generation:**

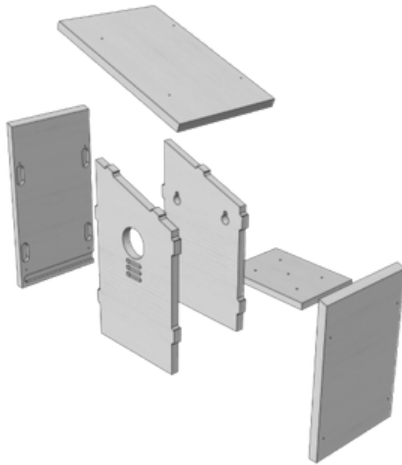
Its important to clean out your birdhouse at the end of each breeding season. Check out our Birdhouse FAQs online for more information.

# Assembly instructions:

Your Kohab Birdhouse has been designed to go together nice and easily. It has interlocking tabs that will hold it in shape and part drilled holes for the nails - it couldn't be easier.



1. If you're mounting it on a fence or wall, mark the spot the screws will go using the back of the birdhouse as a guide. If you want to hang it from a tree use strong wire fed through the mounting screw holes
2. Simply slot the pieces together leaving out the slide in base
3. Give it a good tap all around to help align the pieces
4. Hammer in the nails in the nail holes, start with the roof first
5. Finally slide the base.
