

The 1st Annual Jazz4Justice Juneteenth Festival in DC will take place on Monday, June 20th (Juneteenth Holiday) for a full afternoon of live music and activism to help close the Justice Gap.

Presented by Jazz4Justice, Jazz4Justice Juneteenth Festival will bring out hundreds of DMV residents to enjoy back-to-back sets of live music, an art exhibit, free food and drink, a raffle, and more.

The event is free and open to the public, with a suggested donation of \$20 at the door. All door proceeds will go directly to the Legal Aid Society of the District of Columbia, an organization which provides pro bono legal services to low income individuals for civil legal cases.

About Jazz4Justice and the Justice Gap:

Eighty Six percent (86%) of low income Americans who have civil legal problems receive inadequate or no legal help. Seventy One percent (71%) of low-income households experienced at least one civil or legal problem in the last year. (Source: 2017 Justice Gap Report). This discrepancy between legal representation for civil cases and the need for legal services for low-income individuals is known as the "Justice Gap." Jazz4Justice helps close the Justice Gap by creating partnerships for concerts and festivals in order to raise funds to support Legal Services and Jazz Scholarships.

Jazz4Justice is now seeking a lead sponsor to help us reach our \$10,000 fundraising goal. Jazz4Justice events take place year round across multiple cities in Virginia and DC.
